Canadian air carriers including their international services, continued to show considerably improved revenues in April of the current year. Total operating revenues reached a peak of \$7,066,211 for the month and exceeded the April, 1951 total of \$5,278,389 by \$1,787,822 or 33.9 per cent. Operating expenses also were much higher this April, advancing 34.7 per cent to \$6,907,150 with the result that the net operating revenue of the industry rose only slightly from \$151,918 to \$159,061. While the net operating revenue of the domestic and trans-border services of schedulsd carriers were down to \$162,088 from \$207,668 a year earlier, betterment was recorded for non-scheduled carriers, up to \$10,528 from a deficit of \$35,685, and on the Atlantic and Pacific services of the scheduled lines.

All revenue accounts for April registered gains over the corresponding period last year. Revenue passenger farss were up from \$3,346,489 to \$4,034,098 or by 20.5 per cent. Mail and goods transported isproved also, providing revenues of \$855,057 and \$365,479 to the carriers as compared to \$735,477 and \$306,813 respectively, in the preceding April. Revenues from bulk transportation rose much more sharply to \$1,195,216 or 74.4 per cent higher than in the same period of 1951 when total receipts amounted to \$635,430 Aircraft operation and maintenance charges rose from \$2,979,421 to \$4,016,247 with increased mileage while ground expenses were up \$522,469 to \$1,746,242. Traffic and administration expenses and taxes were also heavier this April. Operation statistics of Canadian carriers show advances for the month similar to the revenue and expense accounts. The total number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll transportation improved to 125,990 from 103,856 a gain of 22,134 or 21.3 per cent while the number of passenger miles increased to 58,988,966 from 48,745,764 miles or by 21.0 per cent. The average flight was the number flown during the previous April.

Passengers carried in bulk transportation (charter or contract) numbered 23,004, almost 2½ times the number flown during the previous April.

The total weight of all revenue goods transported by Canadian air carriers in unit toll transportation amounted to 2,381,756 ibs. and showed an increase of 491,817 lbs. or 26.0 per cent over the same month of 1951. Goods ton-miles rose to 782,592,or by 32.2 per cent. Goods carried in bulk transportation at 5,998,281 lbs. amounted to more than five times the total of the preceding April, namely 1,094,664 lbs. Mail also shared in the general improvement rising to 1,262,435 from 1,069,862 lbs. which were carried 448,489 ton miles against 376,778 one year earlier. Morthern developments are greatly dependent on air service.

As to be expected, the increased activity as shown in the above analysis resulted in more hours and miles flown. The number of hours logged in unit toll transportation reached a total of 17,747 and covered a distance of 3,004,518 miles as compared to 14,968 hours and 2,558,276 miles in April of 1951. An additional 10,535 hours and 1,296,893 miles were logged for bulk transportation against 6,489 hours and 745,621 miles, respectively.
