Canadian air carriers reported a record volume of traffic along with peak revenues for the month of June. Total operating revenues amounted to \$8,443,111 for the month, an advance of \$1,435,877 or 20.5 per cent over the \$7,007,2% earned in June of 1951. Total operating expenses, however, rose 31.3 per cent, from \$5,492,502 to \$7,212,782, with the result that no operating revenues declined to \$1,230,329 from \$1,514,732. The net operating revenues of the domestic and international services of the scheduled carriers and the non-scheduled carriers were all lower this June. The total amount of goods and the number of passengers carried during the month at 11,394,650 lbs. and 187,733 were up considerably from the June, 1951 totals of 5,480,019 lbs. and 170,317, respectively. The amount of mail carried was slightly less this June at 1,097,657 lbs. against 1,117,472.

In the first six months of the current year, the civil aviation industry in Canada continued to show that remarkable progress which has been consistant since the end of the war. New peaks have been established each month for most of the financial accounts and operational data. On the revenue side, all accounts were considerably higher for the six month period this year. Passenger revenue received from unit toll transportation amounted to \$24,202,518, up \$3,023,292 or 14.3 per cent over the similar six months of 1951 at \$21,179,226 and goods transported provided revenues of \$2,247,919 as compared with \$1,820,522 for a gain of 23.5 per cent. Bulk transportation receipts rose even more rapidly to a total of \$7,328,284 or 58.3 per cent higher than in the first half of 1951 due to booming activity in the northern regions of the country. Mail revenues also advanced but to a lesser extent totalling \$4,971,109 against \$4,507,650. Total operating revenues which rose 23.2 per cent to \$41,296,261 from \$33,506,554 did not, however, increase as much as total operating expenses which were up 28.1 per cent to a high of \$39,626,713 as compared to \$30,941,095 to the end of June, 1951. Air operation and maintenance at \$22,951,117 was 26.9 per cent above the previous half year's total of \$18,081,411 and ground operation and maintenance advanced 36.5 per cent to \$10,234,714 from \$7,499,960. As a result net operating revenues for the period were down to \$1,669,548 from \$2,565,459 a year ago despite record traffic volume.

As to be expected, increased revenues and expenses were the result of more passengers, goods and mail being flown more hours and more miles both in June and in the cumulative totals. During the six month period under review, 896,132 passengers were carried a total of 367,537,000 miles by Canadian operators, 135,081 passengers and 65,621,069 passenger miles more than in the corresponding period of 1951. Of the total number of passengers, 735,156 were carried in unit toll transportation and 135,116 in bulk transportation as compared to 652,772 and 84,621 respectively, a year earlier. Goods carried in unit toll transportation amounted to 16,106,167 lbs. versus 13,325,285 lbs., an increase of 20.9 per cent while goods transported in bulk transportation (charter or contract) at 37,139,191 lbs. exceeded the comparable figure for 1951, 10,948,884 lbs. by almost three and a half times. Goods carried in unit toll transportation were flown 5,529,417 ton-miles against 3,519,738. Mail carried increased 677,432 lbs. to 7,732,119 while mail ton miles rose from 2,363,742 to 2,696,460 ton-miles or by 14.1 per cent. Canadian carriers logged a total of 223,996 hours flown on all flights in the first half of this year against 170,735 one year earlier, an increase of 31.2 per cent most of which occurred in bulk transportation. Miles flown in unit toll transportation aggregated 18,038,431 up 2,198,470 over the 1951 six month total of 15,839,961 miles.
