Total operating revenues of Canadian air carriers for the month of April were well above the similar month of 1952, advancing \$\gred{3}1,28\gred{3}\$ or \$4.7\$ per cent to \$\frac{7}{3}97,494\$ from \$\frac{9}{7},066,211\$. Total operating expenses, however, rose more rapidly to \$\frac{9}{7},577,537\$ from \$\frac{6}{7},907,150\$, a gain of \$\frac{6}{7}03,387\$ or 9.7 per cent. As a result, the net operating income of the carriers declined from \$\frac{9}{1}59,061\$ in April, 1952 to a deficit of \$\frac{9}{1}80,043\$. Both the scheduled and non-scheduled operators fared less well this April. The scheduled airlines received operating revenues of \$\phi\_6\624,162\$ as compared with \$\phi\_5\941,734\$ in the previous April and expended \$\phi\_6\658,438\$ against \$\phi\_5\793,201\$. A deficit of \$\grec{9}{3}4,312\$ was thus reported as opposed to a surplus of \$\frac{9}{4}48,533\$ one year earlier. The non-scheduled carriers which earned \$\frac{7}{7}3,368\$ and spent \$\frac{9}{9}9,099\$, reported a deficit of \$\frac{9}{4}45,731\$ whereas in the previous April, they netted \$\phi\_0528\$.

Total revenues received for unit toll transportation services amounted to \$5,856,057 of which \$4,576,119 were for passenger fares, \$814,860 for mail, \$421,605 for the carriage of goods and \$43,473 for excess baggage. In the similar period of 1952, passenger fares totalled \$4,034,098, mail \$855,057, goods \$363,479 and excess baggage \$34,887, a total of \$5,267,521. Revenue received for bulk transportation services declined slightly to \$1,161,997 from \$1,195,216. The cost of aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$4,364,290 from \$4,016,247 and ground operation and maintenance expenses were up to \$1,906,959 from \$1,746,242. Traffic and general administration were also higher this April while taxes declined to \$34,943 from \$41,462.

During April, Canadian aircraft flew 3,158,926 miles in unit toll transportation, remaining aloft a total of 17,944 hours. This compares, favorably, with 3,004,518 miles flown during 17,747 hours in the corresponding period of 1952. In addition, Canadian planes travelled 1,239,860 miles in 10,030 hours in bulk transportation, down from the April 1952 total of 1,296,893 miles in 10,535 hours.

The total number of revenue passengers carried by all Canadian carriers aggregated 162,032 of which 144,366 were transported in unit toll transportation and 17,666 in bulk transportation. In April, 1952, the comparable total was 148,994 of which 125,990 were unit toll passengers and 23,004 bulk transportation passengers. Passenger miles performed in unit toll transportation only, totalled 69,631,685 this April, an increase of 18 per cent over the previous April total of 58,988,966.

Total air freight carried in unit toll transportation weighed 3,086,737 lb. up from 2,381,756 lb. one year earlier, for a gain of 29.6 per cent while goods ton miles rose 9.1 per cent to 853,702 from 782,692 ton miles. The weight of bulk transportation cargoes dropped considerably, however, to 3,751,072 lb. from 5,998,281 lb. in the preceding April with the result that the total weight of all cargoes carried by Canadian companies in April was down to 7,160,222 lb. as compared with 8,790,711 lb. in the same period of 1952. The volume of mail given airlift rose to 1,373,732 lb. from 1,262,435 lb., a gain of 8.8 per cent while mail ton miles advanced to 494,072 from 448,489 ton miles.

Gasoline and oil consumption and costs were up over April 1952. A total of 3,179,635 gallons of gasoline which cost \$989,146 were used against 3,055,391 gallons costing \$964,188 a year earlier. Employment data show that 9,979 employees were engaged in the industry and earned \$3,298,479 for their services during the month as compared with 9,164 who received \$2,877,175 in the corresponding period of 1952.
