Total operating revenues of Canadian air carriers for the month of August were well above the similar month of 1952, advancing \$583,940 or 6 per cent to \$10,343,198 from \$9,759,258. Total operating expenses rose, however, more rapidly to \$9,016,042 from \$7,936,546, a gain of \$1,079,496 or 13.6 per cent. As a result, the net operating income of the carriers declined from \$1,822,712 in August, 1952 to \$1,327,156 and net income from \$1,332,667 to \$1,216,-236. All of this decline was confined to the non-scheduled carriers whose operating revenues were down to \$2,091,330 from \$2,483,176 while their operating expenses rose to \$1,735,638 from \$1,619,918. The scheduled airlines received operating revenues of \$8,251,868 as compared with \$7,276,082 in the previous August and expended \$7,280,404 against \$6,316,628. Operating income thus advanced slightly to \$971,464 from \$959,454.

Total revenues received for unit toll transportation services amounted to \$7,-449,101 of which \$6,171,619 were for passenger fares, \$774,626 for mail, \$441,105 for the carriage of goods and \$61,751 for excess baggage. In the similar period of 1952, passenger fares totalled \$5,279,700, mail \$794,865, goods \$406,079 and excess baggage \$49,425, a total of \$6,-530,069. Revenue earned from bulk transportation services rose to \$2,193,933 from \$1,946,991, a gain of \$246,942 or 12.7 per cent. The cost of aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$5,411,882 from \$4,887,212 and ground operation and maintenance expenses were up to \$2,206,520 from \$1,910,397. Traffic and general administration charges were also higher during August while general taxes declined to \$35,114 from \$48,396.

During the month, Canadian air carriers flew a total of 3,812,554 revenue miles in unit toll transportation and an additional 2,627,198 miles in bulk transportation. The total revenue miles flown thus amounted to 6,439,752 as compared with 6,015,940 in the corresponding period of 1952. The August 1953 total was accomplished in 53,090 hours as against 52,962 a year earlier.

The number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll transportation totalled 180,622, up 18,914 or 11.7 per cent over the same month of 1952 while the number of revenue passenger miles rose from 77,904,217 to 90,792,096 or by 16.5 per cent indicating a longer average journey. In addition, 54,405 passengers were transported in bulk transportation as compared with 41,704 in the previous August. The total weight of goods carried in unit toll transportation aggregated 2,779,904 lbs., a gain of 352,329 lbs. or 14.5 per cent over the August, 1952 total of 2,427,575 lbs. while goods ton miles advanced to 839,815 from 712,124. The amount of goods flown in bulk transportation also rose appreciably from 13,274,022 lbs. to 17,293,685. The amount of mail given airlift increased to 1,259,453 lbs. from 1,129,318 while mail ton miles rose to 476,159 from 421,003.

Employment in the industry was much higher than in the previous August as the number of employees totalled 10,819 as compared with 9,720 and they received \$3,544,032 in wages against \$3,089,256.
