

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CIVIL AVIATION

DECEMBER, 1954

Canadian air carriers reported total operating revenues of \$7,997,839 for December, a new high for the month and \$327,066 or 4.3 per cent above the \$7,670,773 registered for December 1953. Operating expenses, though higher than in the previous year, advanced only \$94,-393 or 1.1 per cent to \$8,915,957 from \$8,821,564 resulting in an operating loss of \$918,118 as compared with the deficit of \$1,150,791 reported one year earlier. Both the scheduled and non-scheduled carriers experienced losses of \$445,020 and \$473,098 respectively.

Most of the individual revenue and expense accounts increased in varying degrees with passenger traffic remaining the most important income source, totalling \$5,035,667 as compared with \$4,671,836 last December. Mail revenues rose to \$1,144,336 from \$1,012,053, goods advanced to \$675,309 from \$556,747 and excess baggage was higher at \$55,-479 as against \$42,653. In addition, Canadian carriers earned \$730,436 through bulk transportation services, a considerable decrease from the \$1,045,124 of one year ago. Aircraft operation and maintenance charges rose slightly to \$4,663,910 from \$4,608,642, ground operation and maintenance expenses were higher at \$2,469,446 as against \$2,376,620 while traffic and general administration charges were lower than in the preceding December. Taxes increased to \$54,653 from \$31,988.

During the month, Canadian aircraft flew 3,495,345 miles in revenue unit toll transportation services which required a flying time of 19,572 hours. This compares with 3,363,344 miles and 18,958 hours in the corresponding month of 1953. In addition, 757,472 miles were flown in 5,967 hours in bulk transportation, down somewhat from the 908,022 miles and 6,594 hours of one year previous.

The number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll services rose to 156,503 from 143,610 and those carried in bulk transportation services totalled 13,130 as compared to 17,428 in December 1953. Revenue passenger miles rose 12.8 per cent to 77,984,725 from 69,161,949.

Revenue goods carried in unit toll transportation services weighed 4,339,421 lbs., up 1,108,376 lbs. or 34.3 per cent from 3,231,-045 lbs. in the previous year. Revenue goods ton miles rose 40.3 per cent to 1,472,715 from 1,050,059. Bulk transportation cargoes declined sharply to 2,512,807 lbs. from 5,974,614 lbs. a decrease of 57.9 per cent. The amount of mail carried by air advanced to 2,675,893 lbs. from 2,030,787 lbs. and mail ton miles rose to 992,965 from 790.174.


