# CIVIL AVIATION

# FEBRUARY, 1954

During February, the total operating revenues of Canadian air carriers, although up 5 per cent to \$6,551,865 from \$6,238,690, failed to keep pace with total operating expenses which rose 13.4 per cent to \$7,734,405 from \$6,821,753 in the corresponding period of 1953. As a result the operators reported an operating loss of \$1,182,540 as compared with one of \$583,063 in the previous February. The operating deficit was greater for the scheduled carriers and slightly less for the non-scheduled operators. The scheduled airlines received operating revenues of \$5,880,917 as compared with \$5,534,176 in the preceding February and expended \$6,954,297 as against \$6,007,950. The operating loss for the month thus rose to \$1,073,380 from \$473,774. The non-scheduled carriers which earned \$670,948 and spent \$780,108 reported a deficit of \$109,160 as compared with a loss of \$109,289 in the same month of 1953.

Revenue received for the transportation of passengers in unit toll transportation services rose to \$4,107,249, a gain of \$446,641 or 12.2 per cent over the February, 1953 total of \$3,660,608. Mail revenue increased to \$881,376 from \$854,287 and excess baggage produced \$49,053 as against \$39,371 while freight revenue remained about the same. Total unit toll transportation revenues thus rose to \$5,442,077 from \$4,958,690, a gain of 9.7 per cent. Revenue received for bulk transportation services was considerably less than in the previous February amounting to \$780,599 as compared with \$1,008,618. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs rose to \$4,178,560 from \$3,793,860 in February, 1953; ground operation and maintenance expenses increased to \$2,149,171 from \$1,841,913; traffic charges were up to \$872,312 from \$780,247 and general administration cost \$497,091 in the current February as compared with \$375,319 in the same period a year earlier.

In February, Canadian air carriers flew a total of 2,935,909 revenue miles in the performance of unit toll transportation services in 16,405 hours as compared with 2,803,484 miles in 16,290 hours in the previous February. In addition, 791,826 miles were flown in bulk transportation services in 6,449 hours somewhat below the February, 1953 total of 1,070,949 miles which required a flying time of 8,565 hours.

The total number of passengers carried aggregated 143,931 of which 127,732 were transported in revenue unit toll transportation services and 11,959 in bulk transportation services. In the same month of 1953, the total amounted to 138,366 of which 120,090 were unit toll passengers and 14,523 bulk or charter passengers. Revenue passenger miles flown in unit toll transportation rose to 63,795,906 from 56,842,922, an increase of 12.2 per cent. Total air freight carried in revenue unit toll transportation weighed 3,041,620 lbs. up from 2,662,987 lbs. in the previous February a gain of 14.2 per cent while goods ton miles rose 11.2 per cent to 903,550 from 812,879. Bulk transportation cargoes decreased to 5,066,043 lbs. from 6,318,765. The amount of mail given airlift rose to 1,684,638 lbs. from 1,410,120 and mail ton miles to 541,064 from 469,545.
