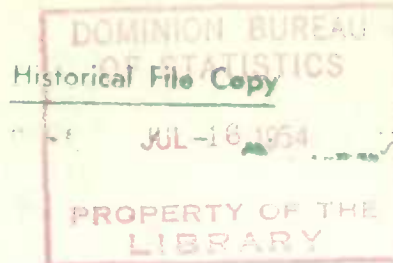

CIVIL AVIATION

MARCH, 1954

As for the past several months, the operating loss of Canadian air carriers was higher than in the corresponding month of 1953. Operating expenses which rose to \$7,949,214 from \$7,291,848, a gain of 9 per cent, increased more rapidly than operating revenues which advanced 5.7 per cent to \$7,704,460 from \$7,289,053. The operating loss thus amounted to \$244,754 as compared with \$2,795 in the previous March. Both the scheduled and non-scheduled operators fared less well this March. The scheduled carriers earned \$6,891,210 and expended \$7,101,280, thus operating at a loss of \$210,070 as compared with a profit of \$27,124 a year earlier, while the operating loss of the non-scheduled airlines increased to \$34,684, from \$29,919.

Increases were reported for all of the financial accounts, except bulk transportation revenue which dropped to \$996,121 from \$1,263,280 in March, 1953. Passenger fares received for unit toll transportation services rose to \$4,848,589, a gain of \$511,699 or 11.8 per cent over the March, 1953 total of \$4,336,890. Mail revenue increased to \$924,583 from \$884,911, the transportation of goods produced \$467,679, up slightly from \$426,659 and excess baggage receipts amounted to \$54,257 as against \$52,394. Total unit toll transportation revenues thus rose to \$6,295,108 from \$5,700,854 or 10.4 per cent. The cost of aircraft operation and maintenance advanced to \$4,466,172 from \$4,241,031; ground operation and maintenance costs rose to \$2,071,282 from

\$1,810,680; traffic expenses increased to \$900,735 from \$822,544 and general administration was up to \$469,375 from \$383,121.

The total number of passengers carried by Canadian air carriers during March aggregated 169,250, an increase of 10,494 or 6.6 per cent over the March, 1953 total of 158,756. The number transported in revenue unit toll services advanced to 148,306 from 137,741 while the number of revenue passenger miles rose to 76,222,018 from 66,359,868. The number flown in bulk transportation services declined to 15,772 from 16,368. The total weight of revenue goods flown in unit toll transportation amounted to 3,273,071 lbs. a gain of 191,984 lbs. or 6.2 per cent over the similar month of 1953 and revenue goods ton miles rose to 1,057,036 from 879,526, or 20.2 per cent. Goods carried in charter or contract flights totalled 5,313,179 lbs. as compared with 3,873,067 lbs. a year earlier. The volume of mail given airlift totalled 2,089,871 lbs. as against 1,554,912 while mail ton miles increased to 681,253 from 558,583.

During the month, 619 aircraft owned or leased by Canadian carriers flew a total of 3,346,257 miles in revenue unit toll transportation services in 18,686 hours and logged 1,019,225 miles in 8,293 hours in bulk transportation services. In the previous March, 608 aircraft flew 3,092,132 miles in 17,944 hours in unit toll and 1,306,502 miles in 10,862 hours in bulk transportation.

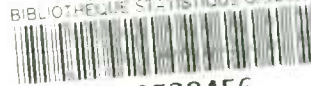
