# APRIL, 1954

Total operating revenues of Canadian air carriers for the month of April were well above the similar period of 1953, advancing \$236,932 or 3.2 per cent to \$7,634,426 from \$7,397,494. Total operating expenses rose, however, more rapidly to \$7,986,620 from \$7,577,537 a gain of \$409,083 or 5.4 per cent. As a result the net operating loss rose from \$180,043 in April, 1953 to \$352,194. The scheduled carriers received operating revenues of \$7,023,395 as compared with \$6,624,126 in the previous April, and expended \$7,222,284 as against \$6,658,438. Their operating loss thus advanced to \$198,889 from \$34,312. The non-scheduled airlines earned \$611,031 and spent \$764,336 for a deficit of \$153,305 as compared with revenues of \$773,368, expenses of \$919,099 and a deficit of \$145,731 in April of the previous year.

Total revenue received for unit toll transportation services amounted to \$6,469,990 of which \$5,013,019 were for passenger fares, \$924,734 for mail, \$477,051 for the transportation of goods and \$55,186 for excess baggage. In the corresponding period of 1953, passenger fares totalled \$4,576,119 mail \$814,860, goods \$421,605 and excess baggage \$43,473, a total of \$5,856,057. Revenue earned from bulk transportation services declined to \$844,979 from \$1,161,997, a decrease of \$317,018 or 27.3 per cent. The cost of aircraft operation and maintenance decreased slightly to \$4,362,730 from \$4,364,290 while ground operation and maintenance expenses rose 12.6 per cent to \$2,146,878 from \$1,906,959 and traffic costs increased to \$939,274 from \$877,716. General administration expense and general taxes were also higher than in the previous April.

In April, Canadian air carriers logged a total of 3,410,512 miles in the performance of revenue unit toll transportation services in 19,297 hours as compared with 3,158,926 miles in 17,944 hours one year earlier. In addition, 830,272 miles were flown in bulk transportation services in 6,778 hours, considerably below the April, 1953 total of 1,239,860 miles which required a flying time of 10,030 hours.

During the thirty day period covered, 176,696 passengers were flown as compared with 166,652 in the same month of 1953. Of the month's total, 157,399 were carried in unit toll transportation and 13,883 in chartered flights as against 144,366 and 17,666, respectively, during April, 1953. Revenue unit toll transportation passenger miles rose to 77,393,738 from 69,631,685. The total amount of goods carried declined to 6,655,479 lbs., from 7,160,222. Revenue unit toll transportation cargoes aggregated 3,251,473 lbs., up from 3,086,737 lbs. a year earlier while revenue goods ton miles rose to 1,150,469. Goods transported in bulk transportation decreased to 3,054,315 lbs. from 3,751,072. The amount of mail carried advanced to 1,946,477 lbs. from 1,373,732 while mail ton miles rose to 691,747 from 494,072.
