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### CIVIL AVIATION

#### JULY, 1954

Total operating revenues reported by Canadian air carriers for the month of July amounted to \$10,463,985 exceeding the July, 1953 total of \$10,241,738 by \$222,247 or 2.2 per cent. Operating expenses were considerably lower at \$8,735,654 compared with \$9,371,917 with the result that net operating revenues increased to \$1,728,331 from \$869,821. The net operating income of the scheduled carriers rose to \$1,249,775 from \$407,664 while the non-scheduled carriers netted \$478,556, an increase of \$16,399.

Revenue received for the transportation of passengers in unit toll transportation services advanced to \$6,809,797 from \$5,832,659 a gain of \$977,138 or 16.8 per cent, mail revenue provided \$888,194 up from \$744,897 and goods brought \$471,945 as compared with \$424,550 in the previous July. Excess baggage revenues amounted to \$72,649 against \$63,251 while bulk transportation revenues declined from \$2,301,207 to \$1,660,816. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs decreased to \$4,863,622 from \$5,676,144 while ground operation and maintenance charges rose to \$2,283,235 from \$1,995,406. Traffic expenditures increased \$218,238 to \$1,038,-846, general administration required less at \$503,063 compared with \$837,893 and taxes were slightly higher at \$46,888 up from \$41,866 in July of last year.

Revenue unit toll passenger travel aggregated a total of 192,417 patrons, an increase of 18,994 or 11.0 per cent over the July, 1953 total of 173,423 while revenue passenger miles rose 20.7 per cent to 103,472,528 from 85,700,321. In addition, 52,084 passengers were flown in bulk transportation services as compared with 53,380.

Revenue goods ton-miles rose 29.6 per cent from 806,513 to 1,045,353 while freight carried in unit toll transportation services rose 13.6 per cent to 3,131,197 lbs. from 2,755,406. The total amount of revenue goods carried, fell however 51.6 per cent to 10,437,066 lbs. from 21,584,054. Bulk transportation cargoes declined sharply from 18,828,648 lbs. to 7,305,869. Mail carried totalled 1,735,327 lbs. representing 662,503 ton-miles of service compared with 1,292,170 lbs. and 478,688 ton-miles, respectively, in July, 1953.

During the month Canadian carriers flew a total of 4,025,183 revenue miles in unit toll transportation requiring a flying time of 22,592 hours. In the same period a year earlier 3,815,488 miles were flown in 21,415 hours. Also, 2,118,046 miles were flown in 19,111 hours in bulk transportation this July down somewhat from the total of 2,632,278 miles in 22,061 hours of one year ago.
