AUGUST, 1954

During the month of August, a total of 4,142,498 revenue miles were flown by Canadian air carriers in unit toll transportation as compared with 3,812,554 in the same period last year. The number of hours necessary to cover this distance amounted to 23,129 against the 21,894 in the preceding August. In addition, 2,031,118 revenue miles were flown in 18,213 hours in bulk transportation services this month, down from the previous August total of 2,627,198 miles which required 22,491 hours flying time.

An average of 669 planes were used during the month, consuming 4,378,512 gallons of gasoline and 51,861 gallons of oil, the cost of which amounted to \$1,478,003 and \$54,690 respectively. In August 1953, 694 aircraft required 4,232,959 gallons of gasoline and 55,485 gallons of oil at a cost of \$1,470,564 for the gasoline and \$52,778 for oil.

The number of revenue passengers carried totalled 249,628 of which 205,328 were conveyed in unit toll transportation and 44,300 in bulk transportation services. The comparable total for August, 1953 was 235,027 of which 180,622 were unit toll passengers and 54,405 bulk or charter passengers. Revenue passenger miles flown in unit toll transportation totalled 109,934,287 an increase of 19,142,191 or 21.1 per cent over the 90,792,096 for the same period one year previous.

Air transportation was provided for 3,352,029 lbs. of goods in revenue unit toll transportation an increase of 20.6 per cent over the August 1953 total of 2,779,904 lbs. In addition, 6,815,873 lbs. of freight were carried in bulk transportation services this month down 60.6 per cent from the 17,293,685 lbs. reported one year earlier. Revenue goods ton miles performed in unit toll transportation rose from 839,815 to 1,093,426.

The total operating revenues of Canadian air carriers increased \$442,584 or by 4.3 per cent to \$10,785,782 from \$10,343,198. Total operating expenses decreased to \$8,979,753 from \$9,016,042 resulting in a net operating income gain of \$478,873 to \$1,806,029 from the \$1,327,156 reported one year ago.

Total revenues received for unit toll transportation services amounted to \$8,698,235 with passenger fares accounting for 83.4 per cent of this with \$7,257,522. Mail provided \$884,792, goods, \$478,418 and excess baggage \$77,503. In the similar period of 1953, unit toll transportation revenues totalled \$7,449,101 of which \$6,171,619 were for passenger fares, \$774,626 for mail, \$441,105 for goods carried and \$61,751 for excess baggage. Bulk transportation revenue declined to \$1,595,713 from \$2,193,933. Aircraft operation and maintenance expenses declined to \$5,020,751 from \$5,411,882, ground operation and maintenance increased from \$2,206,520 to \$2,372,886, traffic expenses rose to \$1,027,598 compared with \$899,885, general administration costs were up to \$510,982 from \$462,641 and taxes were higher at \$47,536 as against the \$35,114 recorded one year previously.
