

SEPTEMBER, 1954

During September, total operating revenues received by Canadian air carriers amounted to \$10,211,651 a new record for the month of September and a gain of \$605,507 or 6.3 per cent over the September, 1953 total of \$9,606,144. Operating expenses rose only 3.5 per cent to \$8,966,690 from \$8,660,439 with the result that the operating income increased to \$1,244,961 from \$945,705, a gain of \$299,256.

Most of the revenue and expense accounts increased in varying degrees over the corresponding month of 1953. Passenger fares increased to \$6,765,460 from \$6,013,211, a gain of \$752,249 or 12.5 per cent, mail revenue rose to \$863,482 from \$769,519, freight produced revenues of \$506,825 compared with \$475,485 and excess baggage receipts advanced to \$75,937 from \$67,609. Revenue earned from bulk transportation services declined to \$1,514,544 from the \$1,716,211 reported one year earlier. The cost of aircraft operation and maintenance decreased to \$5,079,384 from \$5,199,391 while ground operation and maintenance expenses rose 12.2 per cent to \$2,322,606 from \$2,069,731 and traffic costs increased to \$1,013,035 from \$892,178. General administration and general taxes were also higher than in the previous September.

The number of hours flown by Canadian air carriers in unit toll transportation services amounted to 21,678. A distance of 3,863,555 miles was travelled. These compare with 21,410 hours and 3,705,000 miles in September, 1953. An additional 15,936 hours and 1,820,390 miles were logged for bulk transportation this month against 17,314 hours and 2,033,337 miles in 1953.

The number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll transportation increased to 191,705 from 176,912, a gain of 14,793 or 8.4 per cent while the number of passenger miles increased to 101,548,359 from 89,022,488 or by 14.1 per cent. Revenue passengers carried in bulk transportation services numbered 35,854, down slightly from the 39,090 carried one year ago.

The amount of goods carried in revenue unit toll transportation services totalled 3,265,808 lbs., an increase of 156,060 lbs. over the September, 1953 total of 3,109,748 lbs., however, the weight of bulk cargoes declined to 6,828,078 lbs. from 9,144,071 lbs. with the result that the total amount of revenue goods carried decreased to 10,093,886 lbs. from 12,253,819 lbs. a drop of 17.6 per cent. Goods ton miles performed in revenue unit toll services rose to 1,181,856 from 906,712. The volume of mail transported by air advanced to 1,721,709 lbs. from 1,313,558, while mail ton miles increased to 657,432 from 506,226.
