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CIVIL AVIATION

January, 1955

Total operating revenues received by Canadian air carriers during the month of January amounted to \$7,591,646, exceeding the \$6,991,732 earned in January 1954 by \$599,914 or 8.6 per cent. Total operating expenses increased 7.9 per cent to \$8,393,418 from \$7,781,418 with the result that the loss on operations rose \$12,-086 to \$801,772 as compared with \$789,686 in the previous January.

Increases were reported for all of the financial accounts, except bulk transportation revenue which dropped to \$738,008 from \$802,847 in January, 1954. Passenger fares advanced to \$5,035,060, a gain of \$561,157 or 12.5 per cent over the \$4,473,903 of one year ago. Mail revenue increased to \$904,143 from \$868,677, the transportation of goods provided \$490,866 up from \$394,866 and excess baggage receipts amounted to \$54,924 as against \$48,270. Total unit toll transportation revenues thus rose 12.1 per cent to \$6,484,993 from \$5,785,716. Aircraft operation and maintenance expenses rose to \$4,454,289 from \$4,368,314; ground operation maintenance advanced to \$2,340,464 from \$2,084,529; traffic costs increased to \$1,008,900 from \$856,854 while administration expenditures amounted to \$542,270 compared with \$439,894. General taxes were also higher at \$47,495 from \$31,827.

There were substantial increases in most categories of traffic carried during January. Revenue passengers transported in unit toll services numbered 152,615, increasing 16.2 per cent from 131,336 while those carried in bulk transportation services totalled 16,360 as against 12,755. Revenue passenger miles rose 14.2 per cent to 79,296,051 from 69,429,295.

Revenue goods carried in unit toll transportation services weighed 3,707,735 lbs., an increase of 755,038 lbs. over the January, 1954 total of 2,952,697 lbs., however, the weight of bulk cargoes declined to 2,966,243 lbs. from 4,469,040 lbs. with the result that the total amount of revenue goods carried decreased to 6,673,-978 lbs. from 7,421,737 lbs., a drop of 10.1 per cent. Revenue goods ton miles rose to 1,128,902 from 858,622. The volume of mail transported by air advanced to 1,979,076 lbs. from 1,458,554 lbs. with mail ton miles increasing to 686,792 from 569,051.

During January, Canadian air carriers flew a distance of 3,458,992 miles in revenue unit toll transportation services and required 19,129 hours flying time. This compares with 3,165,336 miles and 17,703 hours for the corresponding period of 1954. An additional 792,463 miles requiring 6,583 hours were flown in bulk transportation services, down slightly from the 822,002 miles and 6,466 hours of January, 1954.

As of January 1955, the number of non-revenue passengers carried, formerly shown on tables 2, 7, 8 and 9 has been dropped from this report.

Note: The operational statistics of Trans World Airlines Inc. are included with the foreign carrier data of this report for the first time.
