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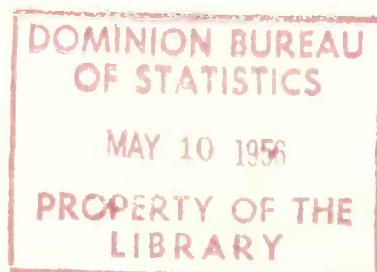

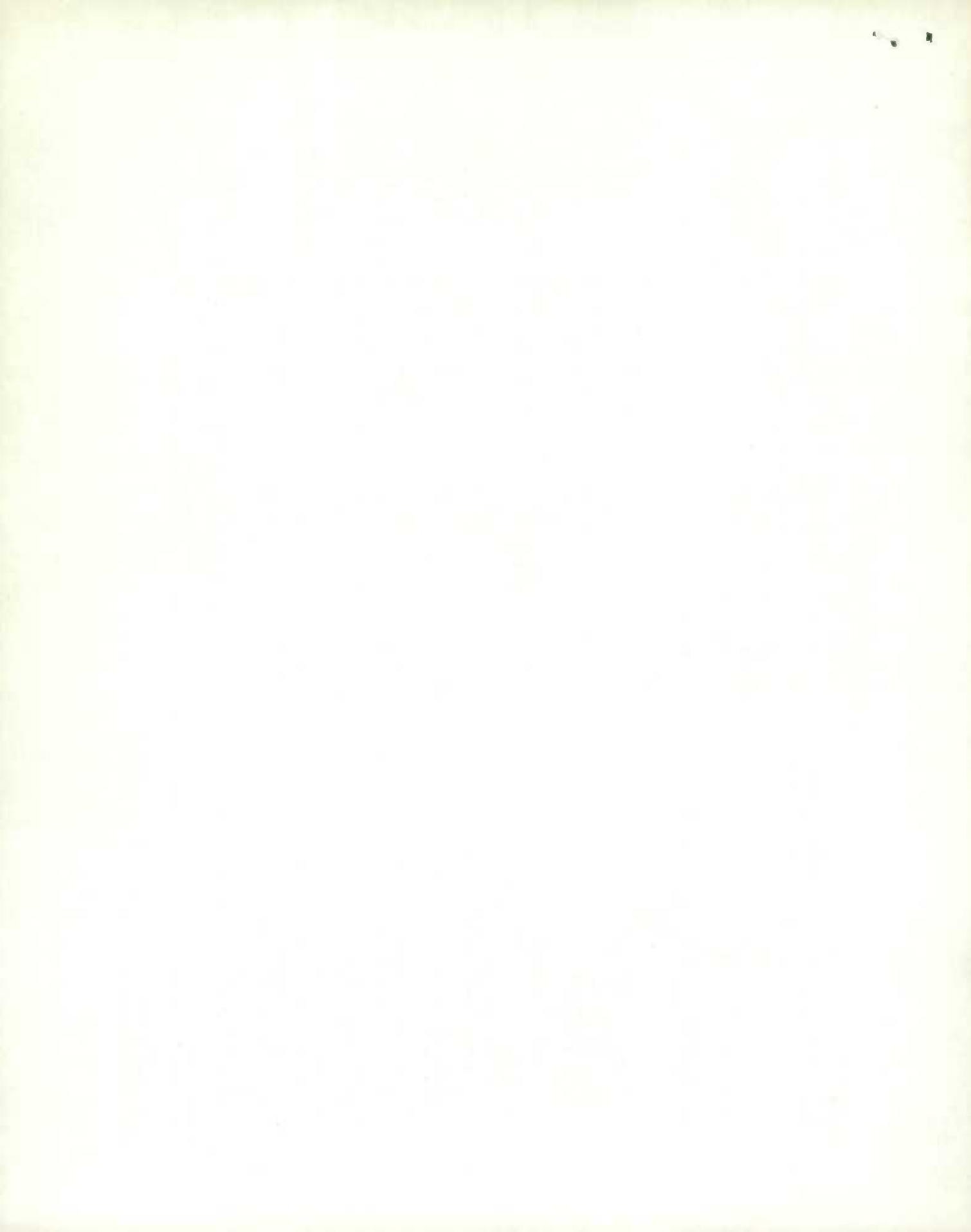

## CIVIL AVIATION

November, 1955

During November total operating revenues received by Canadian air carriers amounted to \$9,040,711, a new high for this month and \$1,727,061 above the November, 1954 total of \$7,313,650. Operating expenses amounted to \$10,129,677 as compared with \$8,323,329 in the previous November, and as a result the seasonal operating loss increased to \$1,088,966 from \$1,009,679 one year earlier.

All revenue accounts except mail showed gains over the corresponding period of 1954. Passenger fares advanced to \$5,345,921, up \$526,034 or 10.9 per cent over the November, 1954 figure of \$4,819,887. Mail revenue dropped to \$873,272 from \$883,924 in the previous November, a decrease of \$10,752. Goods carried produced revenues of \$634,178 compared with \$541,446 and excess baggage charges amounted to \$59,735 as against \$48,750. The only decrease in the expense accounts was in general administration which fell to \$536,662 from \$568,990 one year earlier. Other expenditures were all higher with ground operation rising to \$2,684,719 from \$2,363,694 and aircraft operation and maintenance advancing to \$5,815,052 from \$4,356,262. Traffic expenses and taxes were also higher than in previous November. Salaries and wages paid to 12,562 employees amounted to \$4,493,092 compared with the \$3,930,561 earned by 11,456 employees in November 1954.

Mileage flown by all Canadian air carriers in unit toll transportation amounted to 3,835,587, requiring a flying time of 19,699 hours as compared with 3,325,613 miles and 18,398 hours in November of the previous year. Bulk transportation accounted for a total of 1,214,183 miles flown in 8,563 hours, a considerable increase over the 655,658 miles flown in 5,166 hours in November, 1954.

The number of revenue passengers carried in unit toll transportation services amounted to 179,386, an increase of 27,579 or 18.2 per cent over the November 1954 total of 151,807, while revenue passenger miles rose 21.6 per cent to 90,000,134 from 74,016,080. In addition 15,789 passengers were carried in bulk transportation services as compared with 12,758 in the previous year.

Total revenue goods carried in unit toll transportation weighed 4,066,538 lbs., up 604,117 lbs. or 17.4 per cent from 3,462,421 lbs. in the previous year. Revenue goods ton miles rose to 1,658,602 from 1,284,952. Bulk transportation cargoes more than trebled rising to 8,454,176 lbs. from 2,155,180 lbs. This was due principally to the materials that continued to be flown to northern Canada for work on defence projects. Mail carried during the month totalled 2,005,666 lbs. representing 777,679 ton miles of service, compared with 1,837,780 lbs. and 703,287 ton miles in November, 1954.
