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CIVIL AVIATION

MARCH, 1955

Total operating revenues reported by Canadian air carriers for the month of March amounted to \$9,425,648, exceeding the March, 1954 total of \$7,704,460 by \$1,721,188 or 22.3 per cent. Operating expenses for the month amounted to \$9,580,253 up from \$7,949,214 in the previous March, a rise of \$1,631,039 or 20.5 per cent. Consequently the operating loss of \$154,605 was a slight improvement over the deficit of \$244,754 reported one year ago.

A further indication of the continuing growth of the industry is reflected in the revenue accounts which all show substantial increases this month. Passenger fares rose to \$5,399,947 from \$4,848,589, mail revenues advanced to \$958,301 from \$924,583 and earnings from the carriage of goods increased to \$581,297 from \$467,679. An additional \$67,837 was received in excess baggage charges as compared with \$54,-257 a year earlier. Bulk transportation revenue produced an impressive \$1,789,345 as compared with \$996,121, an advance of \$793,224 or 79.6 per cent.

Operating expense items were also higher in keeping with the increased traffic and mileage. Aircraft operation and maintenance required \$5,366,640 during the month, up from \$4,466,172, while ground operation and maintenance charges increased to \$2,437,383 from \$2,071,282. Traffic expenses rose to \$1,096,649 from \$900,735 and general administration costs were up to \$629,639 from \$469,375. General taxes were also somewhat higher.

Total revenue miles flown by Canadian carriers during the month rose from 4,365,482 miles in the previous March to a high of 4,956,480; of this total 3,512,511 miles were logged in unit toll transportation and 1,443,969 miles in bulk transportation services. The comparative totals of one year ago were 3,346,257 miles flown in unit toll and only 1,019,225 in bulk transportation. Similarly the number of hours flown rose to 19,711 and 11,264 respectively, as compared with 18,686, and 8,293 for the same period of 1954.

Over the thirty-one day period, a total of 173,234 revenue passengers were transported by air of which 157,103 were carried in unit toll transportation services and 16,131 in bulk transportation. In the previous March, 164,078 passengers were carried, 148,306 of which were unit toll and 15,772 bulk. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 9.2 per cent to 83,198,854 from 76,222,018.

The weight of goods carried in revenue unit toll transportation amounted to 3,889,177 lb. up 616,106 lb. or 18.8 per cent over the preceding March while revenue goods ton miles advanced from 1,057,036 to 1,320,406 ton miles or by 24.9 per cent. Goods transported in bulk transportation rose more sharply to 6,780,261 lb. from 5,313,179. The amount of mail carried also shared in the general increase rising to 2,284,106 lb. from 2,089,871 which were carried 753,404 ton miles as compared with 681,253 one year earlier.
