

Total operating revenues reported by Canadian air carriers for the month of October amounted to \$14,270,241, exceeding the October 1955 total of \$12,354,431 by \$1,915,810, or 15.5 per cent. Operating expenses for the month amounted to \$13,706,386 as against \$12,073,750 in the previous October, an increase of \$1,632,955 or 13.5 per cent. The resulting operating income amounted to \$563,855, or over twice that of \$280,681 reported for the same period one year ago.

The individual revenue accounts all showed substantial increases. Passenger fares rose to \$8,615,871 from \$6,935,186, a gain of 24.2 per cent; mail revenues amounted to \$920,085 against \$862,556 and goods carried earned \$823,136 as compared with \$723,638. An additional \$112,753 was earned in excess baggage charges which amounted to \$83,264 a year earlier.

Operating expense accounts also rose considerably in October 1956. Aircraft operation and maintenance required \$8,195,715 during the month, up from \$7,522,857, while ground operation and maintenance charges increased to \$3,267,248 from \$2,640,504. Traffic expenses rose to \$1,362,580 from \$1,187,079 and general administration costs were up to \$822,124 from \$672,150. General taxes amounted to \$58,719 against \$51,160 in the previous October.

During the period under review a total of 304,442 revenue passengers were transported by Canadian air carriers, 259,263 being carried in unit toll transportation services and 45,179 in bulk transportation. In the previous October 248,529 passengers were carried, 214,816 in unit toll services and 33,713 in bulk services. Foreign air carriers transported a total of 45,567 passengers as against 45,938 in the corresponding month last year. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 27.4 per cent to 131,320,421 from 103,095,297.

Total revenue miles flown by Canadian air carriers during the month rose to 8,018,731 from 6,545,136 in the previous October. Of this total 4,867,907 miles were logged in unit toll transportation and 3,150,824 miles in bulk transportation services. In October of the previous year 4,279,044 miles were flown in the performance of unit toll services and 2,266,092 miles in bulk services. Unit toll services required a flying time of 24,621 hours, while 25,606 hours were used in bulk transportation flying. Comparative figures for October, 1955, were 22,526 and 18,944 respectively.

During October, Canadian air carriers handled a total of 2,045,817 lbs. of mail representing 827,076 ton miles, compared with 1,959,963 lbs. and 742,150 ton miles in October, 1955.

The operation of the aircraft which performed these services in this period required 7,334,948 gallons of gasoline and 70,401 gallons of oil at a cost of \$2,194,614 and \$70,292 respectively. In October. 1955, Canadian aircraft consumed 5,507,142 gallons of gasoline costing \$1,769,368 and 75,718 gallons of oil for which \$73,612 was paid.




