

Operations of Canadian air carriers during November produced total operating revenues of \$12,080,979, a gain of \$2,439,091 or 25.3 per cent over the \$9,641,888 reported for the corresponding month last year. Expenses for the month were considerably higher at \$13,405,979, up \$2,619,258 or 24.3 per cent from the \$10,786,721 reported in November, 1955. The seasonal deficit thus amounted to \$1,324,818 as compared with \$1,144,833, an increase of 15.7 per cent.

All individual revenue and expense accounts were considerably higher this November. Passenger fare receipts increased to \$7,401,132 from \$5,809,639; mail revenues rose to \$938,195 from \$899,454; goods carried earned \$843,545 against \$738,234 and excess baggage tolls amounted to \$93,217 in contrast to \$65,848. Bulk transportation services provided an additional \$2,347,673 against \$1,507,127 an increase of 55.8 per cent over the previous November. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs amounted to \$8,068,858 compared with \$6,272,355; ground expenses rose to \$3,163,845 from \$2,759,947 and traffic charges were \$1,324,213 compared with \$1,132,846. General administration expenses at \$794,532 and taxes of \$54,349 were also higher than the \$570,419 and \$51,154 respectively, required for these two items in November, 1955.

Canadian air carriers transported a total of 238,079 revenue passengers during the month, 212,675 being carried in unit toll services, while 25,404 were flown in bulk services. In November, 1955, 195,175 passengers were carried, 179,386 in unit toll services and 15,789 in bulk transportation. Revenue passenger miles rose 28.0 per cent to 115,214,655 from 90,000,134.

During the thirty day period, Canadian air carriers flew a total of 6,206,529 revenue miles in a flying time of 35,677 hours. This compares with 5,049,770 miles and 28,262 hours one year earlier. This month unit toll services required 21,948 hours to fly 4,404,806 miles, while 13,729 hours and 1,801,723 miles were logged in bulk or charter operations. Comparative figures for the previous November show 19,699 hours and 3,835,587 miles flown in unit toll services while 8,563 hours and 1,214,183 miles were recorded for bulk transportation.

A total of 2,081,211 lbs. of airmail was handled representing 868,006 ton miles, compared with 2,005,666 lbs. and 777,679 ton miles in November 1955.

Foreign air carriers operating in Canada transported 39,551 passengers, carried 886,238 lbs. of freight and 175,113 lbs. of mail. Comparative figures for the previous November were 34,546 passengers, 797,755 lbs. of freight and 196,557 lbs. of mail.

During the month Canadian air carriers distributed a total payroll of \$5,351,886 among 13,978 employees, as compared with a payroll of \$4,493,092 shared by 12,562 employees in November, 1955.




