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CIVIL AVIATION

DECEMBER, 1956

During the month of December Canadian air carriers reported total operating revenues of \$13,064,845, exceeding the December, 1955 total of \$10,514,171 by \$2,550,674 or 24.3 per cent. Operating expenses also showed a substantial increase, amounting to \$14,662,969 compared with \$12,178,205 in the previous December, an increase of \$2,484,764 or 20.4 per cent. As a result, the operating loss of \$1,598,124 was \$65,910 or 4.0 per cent less than the deficit of \$1,664,034 reported one year earlier.

Most of the individual revenue and expense accounts showed significant increases over the corresponding period of 1955. Revenue from passenger fares jumped to \$7,505,200 from \$6,224,758; mail carried earned \$1,227,137 against \$1,068,354; receipts from the carriage of goods dropped slightly to \$1,001,159 from \$1,059,222 and excess baggage accounted for \$87,650, up from \$72,096. Bulk transportation revenue of \$2,630,428 was considerably higher than the \$1,680,602 earned by this type of service in December, 1955. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs were up to \$8,740,950 from \$7,054,137; ground expenses rose to \$3,633,236 from \$3,199,872 and traffic charges increased to \$1,294,919 from \$1,148,021. General administration expenses amounted to \$930,727 against \$708,298, while general taxes dropped slightly to \$63,137 from \$67,877 in December of the previous year.

A total of 229,298 revenue passengers was flown during the month by Canadian air carriers, 203,028 being carried in unit toll services while 26,270 were transported in bulk services. In December of the previous year 207,563 passengers were carried, 188,809 using unit toll services and 18,754 being flown in bulk services. Revenue passenger miles rose to 114,882,846 from 95,638,017, an increase of 20.1 per cent.

During the month Canadian air carriers flew a total of 4,602,718 miles in unit toll services in a flying time of 23,356 hours. Bulk services accounted for an additional 2,060,749 miles and 16,024 hours flown. In December, 1955, 4,126,157 miles were flown in 21,418 hours in the performance of unit toll services while 1,534,158 miles and 10,284 hours were logged for bulk services.

The volume of mail transported by air increased to 2,844,613 lbs. from 2,831,726 lbs. with mail ton miles advancing to 1,171,534 from 1,129,719.

Operations of foreign air carriers in Canada show that 39,726 passengers, 822,692 lbs. of freight and 257,276 lbs. of mail were flown during the month. Comparative figures for December, 1955, were 37,243 passengers, 756,376 lbs. of freight and 301,723 lbs. of mail.

The operations of Canadian air carriers this month were performed by a fleet of 819 aircraft, compared with the 628 aircraft which took part in the operations reported for December, 1955.




