

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CIVIL AVIATION

February, 1956

During the month of February, Canadian air carriers reported total operating revenues of \$10,823,850, exceeding the February 1955 total of \$7,411,141 by \$3,412,709 or 46. per cent. Total operating expenses also rose considerably, amounting to \$12,-195,019 compared with \$8,493,758 in the previous February an increase of \$3,701,261 or 43.6 per cent. As a result, the operating loss this year of \$1,371,169 was \$288,552 greater than the deficit of \$1,082,617 reported one year ago. This same pattern of increased revenues failing to keep pace with increased costs has been apparent for the last few months.

All revenue and expense accounts showed substantial gains over the corresponding period last year. Passenger ticket sales amounted to \$5,869,602 as against \$4,577,430; mail carried earned \$974,711, up from \$868,124; goods carried accounted for \$648,546 up from \$500,156 and excess baggage receipts rose to \$71,103 from \$54,647. Bulk transportation services jumped to \$2,854,702 from the \$959,827 reported a year ago, an increase of \$1,894,875 or nearly three times the 1955 figure.

Aircraft operation and maintenance costs rose sharply to \$7,365,327, an increase of \$2,856,641 or 63.4 per cent above the \$4,508,686 of a year ago. Ground operation and maintenance costs were higher at \$2,870,702 compared with \$2,344,727, while traffic expenses climbed to \$1,173,834 from \$998,098. Taxes and administration accounts also showed an increase over the previous February.

The total number of revenue passengers conveyed by Canadian carriers in unit toll transportation services amounted to 178,377 up from 140,571, an increase of 37,806 or 26.9 per cent while the number of revenue passenger miles flown increased to 94,665,-162 from 70,908,790. An additional 89,884 passengers were transported in bulk transportation services as compared with 15,164 flown in this type of service in February, 1955.

A total of 2,341,577 lbs. of mail, representing 764,830 ton miles was handled as compared with 2,078,110 lbs. and 664,019 ton-miles a year ago.

The number of revenue hours flown this month in unit toll transportation services amounted to 20,825 and covered a distance of 3,974,479 miles as compared with 17,140 hours and 3,085,208 miles a year ago. Bulk transportation services accounted for an additional 15,922 hours and 2,149,164 miles flown against 7,457 hours and 923,912 miles for the corresponding period a year ago.




