

MARCH, 1956

Total operating revenues earned by Canadian Air Carriers during March amounted to \$13,725,553, an increase of \$4,299,905 or 45.6 per cent over the \$9,425,648 recorded for the corresponding period a year ago. Total expenses advanced to a lesser extent, rising to \$12,953,600 from \$9,580,253, an increase of \$3,373,347 or 35.2 per cent, resulting in an operating income of \$771,953 as compared with a deficit of \$154,605 in March 1955.

Substantial increases were reported for all revenue accounts. Passenger fares accounted for the major portion of earnings, amounting to \$6,958,648 as opposed to \$5,399,947 in the previous March. Mail earnings rose to \$1,051,970 from \$958,301; goods carried produced \$721,845 against \$581,297 while excess baggage receipts rose to \$80,803 from \$67,837. Bulk transportation revenues totalled \$4,184,152, an increase of \$2,394,807 or more than twice the March, 1955 total of \$1,789,345.

Expense accounts also showed significant increases, the most noticeable being the rise in aircraft and operation costs which amounted to \$7,813,258 as against \$5,366,640, a rise of \$2,446,618 or 45.6 per cent. Ground operation and maintenance expenses advanced to \$3,040,291 from \$2,437,383, while traffic expenses rose to \$1,298,506 from \$1,096,649. General administration charges were up to \$739,830 from \$629,639 and general taxes were also higher than in March of the previous year.

During the month under review Canadian commercial air carriers transported 205,705 passengers in unit toll services as against 157,103 in the corresponding month last year, a gain of 48,602 or 30.9 per cent, while passenger miles increased to 110,042,032 from 83,198,854. Passengers carried in bulk transportation numbered 30,743 as compared with 16,131 in March, 1955.

A total of 2,546,429 lbs. of mail was handled representing 867,997 ton miles, compared with 2,284,106 lbs and 753,404 ton miles a year ago.

The increase in business this month is reflected in the number of hours and miles flown in the various types of service. A total of 23,096 hours was logged in unit total transportation services, while 4,394,502 miles were flown in this type of service, compared with 19,711 hours and 3,512,511 miles a year ago. Bulk transportation flights accounted for an additional 3,147,181 miles and 23,414 hours flown, compared with 1,443,969 miles and 11,264 hours a year ago.

Foreign carriers transported 40,918 passengers between Canada and the United States or Mexico, while 3,604 were carried by foreign aircraft in Atlantic and Pacific services. Comparable figures for March 1955 were 38,294 and 2,400 respectively.




