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CIVIL AVIATION

APRIL, 1956

Canadian air carriers reported a favourable balance for the second successive month, reflecting the continued growth of air transportation in this country. During April total operating revenues amounted to \$14,440,360 up \$3,071,610 or 27.0 per cent from the \$11,368,750 earned in April, 1955.

Operating expenses were also higher advancing to \$13,801,378 from \$11,453,529 an increase of \$2,347,849 or 20.5 per cent. As a result of the gain in operating revenues being more than sufficient to offset the rise in expenses, an operating income of \$638,982 was shown for the month's operations, compared with a deficit of \$84,779 in April, 1955.

All revenues and expense accounts for the period under review showed significant increases. Passenger fares advanced to \$7,262,508 from \$5,716,382; mail revenue rose to \$937,070 from \$901,959; goods transported earned \$738,635 compared with \$592,137 and excess baggage accounted for \$85,495 as compared with \$61,725 in April of the previous year. Bulk transportation revenues rose from \$3,525,004 to \$4,625,470 a gain of \$1,100,466 or 31.2 per cent. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs amounted to \$8,629,715 as against \$7,023,549 due mainly to heavier traffic and increased mileage flown. Ground operation and maintenance charges rose to \$3,016,674 from \$2,618,510; traffic expenses were \$1,316,227 as against \$1,119,124 and general administration costs were \$765,598 compared with \$647,678. General taxes rose sharply to \$73,164 from \$44,668.

As was to be expected, the increased revenues and expenses were due principally to a greater volume of traffic and more miles and hours being flown in the period under review. During the month Canadian carriers flew 4,278,654 miles in unit toll transportation services, logging a total of 21,993 hours. Comparable figures for April, 1955 were 3,762,835 miles and 20,809 hours. An additional 3,154,347 miles were flown in 22,819 hours in the performance of bulk transportation services compared with 2,311,526 miles and 16,877 hours respectively for the same period a year ago.

A total of 217,436 passengers were carried in revenue unit toll services with an additional 29,758 passengers being flown in bulk transportation services resulting in grand total of 247,194 revenue air travellers during the month. In April 1955 a total of 198,369 passengers were reported,177,049 of these using revenue unit toll services, while 21,320 were carried in bulk transportation services.

Airmail handled during the month amounted to 2,095,784 lbs representing 766,592 ton miles in contrast to 1,997,752 lbs and 727,962 ton miles in April of the previous year.

Employment data show that \$5,098,252 was earned by 13,697 employees, while in the same period of the previous year a total payroll of \$4,406,867 was distributed among 12,615 employees.




