

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CIVIL AVIATION

November, 1957

Revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers were up by 3.7 p.c., but cargo flown dropped 39.5 p.c. in November, 1957, as compared with November, 1956. Operating revenue for the month decreased 5.2 p.c. to \$11,449,664 from \$12,080,979, while expenses rose 3.0 p.c. to \$13,807,259 from \$13,405,797. As a result the operating deficit for the month amounted to \$2,357,595 as compared with \$1,324,818, an increase of 78.0 p.c.

All revenue accounts with the exception of express and bulk transportation showed increases over the previous year. Passenger fares increased 5.3 p.c. to \$7,-792,569 from \$7,401,132, mail revenue rose to \$1,019,723 from \$938,195, freight earnings from unit toll service to \$641,106 from \$562,828 and excess baggage revenue to \$102,361 from \$93,217. Bulk transportation revenue, which includes passengers and cargo flown in chartered service, registered a decline of 49.6 p.c., decreasing to \$1,183,648 from \$2,347,673 while express income dropped to \$261,183 from \$280,717.

All expense accounts, with the exception of aircraft operation and maintenance which declined to \$7,928,892 from \$8,068,858, registered increases. Ground operation and maintenance costs rose to \$3,329,281 from \$3,163,845, traffic expenses to \$1,607,814 from \$1,324,213, general administration costs to \$876,822 from \$794,532 and general taxes to \$64,450 from \$54,349.

Canadian air carriers transported 246,792 revenue passengers during November as compared with 238,079 in November, 1956. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 234,651 from 212,675, while those carried in chartered service dropped to 12,141 from 25,404. Revenue unit toll passenger miles increased 5.9 p.c. to 121,967,-069 from 115,214,655.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped 33.4 p.c. to 11,689,847 lb. from 17,555,882 lb. in November of the previous year. Revenue freight declined to 7,930,581 lb. from 13,871,205 lb. and express to 981,239 lb. from 1,199,617 lb. On the other hand, excess baggage carried rose to 447,074 lb. from 403,849 lb. and airmail to 2,-330,953 lb. from 2,081,211 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 5,504,754 from 6,206,529. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 4,763,059 from 4,404,806, but bulk or charter service mileage dropped sharply to 741,695 from 1,801,723.

During the month under review Canadian air carriers had a fleet of 782 aircraft in service as against 886 in November, 1956.

Foreign air carriers reported 37,519 passengers, 706,171 lb. of freight and 153,218 lb. of mail flown into or out of Canada during November. Comparable figures for November, 1956 are 39,551 passengers, 886,238 lb. of freight and 175,113 lb. of mail.




