

FEBRUARY, 1957

Total operating revenues earned by Canadian air carriers during February amounted to \$11,959,377, an increase of \$1,135,527 or 10.5 per cent over the \$10,823,850 reported for the corresponding month one year ago. Total operating expenses advanced to \$13,067,780 from \$12,195,019, an increase of \$872,761 or 7.2 per cent. As a result, the operating deficit for the month amounted to \$1,108,403 as compared with \$1,371,169 in the previous February.

Increases were reported for all revenue accounts with the exception of bulk transportation. Passenger fares brought in \$7,089,280 as against \$5,069,602, an increase of 12.1 per cent. Mail earnings rose to \$998,606 from \$974,711 and freight revenue climbed to \$519,400 from \$451,849 in February, 1956. Express receipts amounted to \$238,843 as against \$196,697, while excess baggage charges were \$96,928 as compared with \$71,103. Bulk transportation revenues dropped to \$2,713,299 from \$2,854,702 in February of the previous year.

Expense accounts all showed increases over the previous February. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs rose to \$7,723,244 from \$7,365,327, ground operation and maintenance charges to \$3,021,021 from \$2,870,702, traffic expenses to \$1,389,524 from \$1,173,834, general administration costs to \$873,294 from \$730,813 and general taxes to \$60,697 from \$54,343.

During the month under review Canadian Commercial air carriers transported 207,370 passengers in unit toll services as against 178,377 in the corresponding month last year. An additional 25,735 passengers were carried in bulk services, compared with 21,285, bringing the total number of passengers carried this month to 233,105, a considerable gain from the 199,662 transported by air in February, 1956. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose to 113,304,849 from 94,665,162, an increase of 19.7 per cent.

A total of 20,196,778 lbs. of freight was handled in February this year, 3,080,741 lbs. in unit toll services and 17,116,037 lbs. in bulk services. The freight carried in February, 1956 amounted to 16,465,184 lbs., consisting of 2,724,633 lbs. of unit toll freight and 13,740,551 lbs. of bulk freight. A total of 962,557 lbs. of express, as against 1,133,530 lbs., was transported, while the excess baggage flown rose to 388,847 lbs. from 260,881 lbs. in the previous February. The volume of airmail carried rose to 2,468,874 lbs. from 2,341,577 lbs. as mail ton miles advanced to 847,674 from 764,830

Canadian air carriers flew 3,987,396 miles in 22,421 hours in the performance of unit toll services, this February, compared with 3,974,479 miles flown in 20,825 hours in this type of service in February, 1956. Bulk transportation services logged 2,584,895 miles and 19,158 hours as against 2,149,164 miles and 15,922 hours one year ago.

This February, Canadian air carriers had 14,440 employees on their payroll, with earnings of \$5,482,286, while in February 1956, a total of 13,183 employees earned \$4,694,015.
