Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during April were up by 17.5 p.c. while revenue cargo dropped 15.2 p.c. as compared with April 1956. Operating revenues rose 0.4 p.c. to \$14,503,790 from \$14,440,360 while operating expenses climbed 3.7 p.c. to \$14,305,161 from \$13,801,378 leaving a net operating income of \$198,629 as compared with \$638,982 in April of the previous year.

For the fourth consecutive month increases over last year were reported for all revenue accounts except express and bulk transportation. Passenger fares accounted for \$8,786,624 as against \$7,262,508; an increase of 21.0 p.c. Mail earnings rose to \$1,078,416 from \$937,070, freight revenue from unit toll service to \$542,085 from \$473,830, excess baggage charges to \$107,584 from \$85,495, while express receipts dropped to \$146,618 from \$264,805. Bulk transportation revenue, which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service, dropped 28.8 p.c. to \$3,294,682 from \$4,625,470.

For the first time in several months there was a decrease in two of the expense accounts, as aircraft operation and maintenance costs dropped to \$8,627,553 from \$8,629,715 and general taxes to \$62,712 from \$73,164 in April, 1956. Ground operation and maintenance charges rose to \$3,133,461 from \$3,016,674, traffic expenses to \$1,584,429 from \$1,316,227, and general administration costs to \$897,006 from \$765,598.

During April, Canadian air carriers transported 290,460 revenue passengers as against 247,194 in April 1956. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 258,589 from 217,436 while those carried in chartered service rose to 31,871 from 29,758. Revenue passenger miles flown increased 19.4 p.c. to 133,406,749 from 111,764,282.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped 15.5 p.c. to 21,986,766 lb. from 26,028,700 in April of the previous year. Revenue freight declined 18.3 p.c. to 18,290,181 from 22,387,365 lb. and express 32.7 p.c. to 830,246 from 1,233,291. On the other hand excess baggage rose to 452,686 lb. from 312,260 lb., an increase of 45.0 p.c., and airmail rose 15.2 p.c. to 2,413,653 lb. from 2,095,784 lb.

Total miles flown increased to 8,149,975 from 7,433,001 in April 1956. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 6,276,503 from 4,278,654 while bulk or charter service dropped to 1,873,472 from 3,154,347.

Foreign air carriers reported 50,385 passengers, 762,994 lb. of freight and 173,696 lb. of mail flown into or out of Canada during April. Comparable figures for April 1956 are 46,181 passengers, 848,325 lb. of freight and 232,087 lb. of mail.




