Revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers were up 5.7 p.c. but revenue cargo dropped 30.3 p.c. in June 1957, as compared with June 1956. Operating revenue for the month decreased 1.6 p.c. to \$17,076,299 from \$17,348,485 and expenses 1.2 p.c. to \$15,021,937 from \$15,207,387. Consequently net operating revenue dropped to \$2,054,362 from \$2,141,098.

All revenue accounts with the exception of express and bulk transportation showed increases over the previous year. Passenger fares increased 19.8 p.c. to \$11,090,080 from \$9,254,625, mail revenue rose to \$984,676 from \$909,346, freight earnings from unit toll service to \$539,749 from \$522,709 and excess baggage revenue to \$117,720 from \$105,012. Bulk transportation revenue, which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service, registered a decline of 37.1 p.c., decreasing to \$3,305,136 from \$5,251,760 in June, 1956.

The two major expense accounts both recorded decreases for the month while the other three accounts registered increases. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs declined to \$9,174,663 from \$9,640,055 and ground charges to \$3,117,851 from \$3,134,028. On the other hand traffic costs rose to \$1,751,967 from \$1,482,186, general administration expenses to \$898,208 from \$879,523 and taxes to \$79,248 from \$71,595.

During June, 1957 Canadian Air carriers transported 352,940 revenue passengers as compared with 334,035 one year earlier. Unit toll passengers increased to 294,981 from 266,430 while chartered service passengers decreased to 57,959 from 67,605. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 22.6 p.c. to 170,577,399 from 139,178,839.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped to 20,563,016 lb. from 29,502,489 lb. in June of the previous year. Revenue freight fell sharply to 16,926,525 lb. from 26,101,852 lb. and express to 967,036 lb. from 1,088,760 lb. However, excess bagged carried rose to 498,541 lb. from 425,524 lb. and airmail to 2,170,914 from 1,886,353 lb.

Total revenue miles flown increased to 10,121,968 from 9,658,012 in June of the previous year. Revenue unit toll service mileage rose to 5,580,567 from 5,097,041, but bulk or charter service dropped to 4,541,401 from 4,560,971.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers in June 1957 amounted to 58,953 passengers, 797,223 lb. of freight and 170,494 lb. of mail. Comparable figures for the previous year are 52,702 passengers, 851,276 lb. of freight and 188,462 lb. of mail.

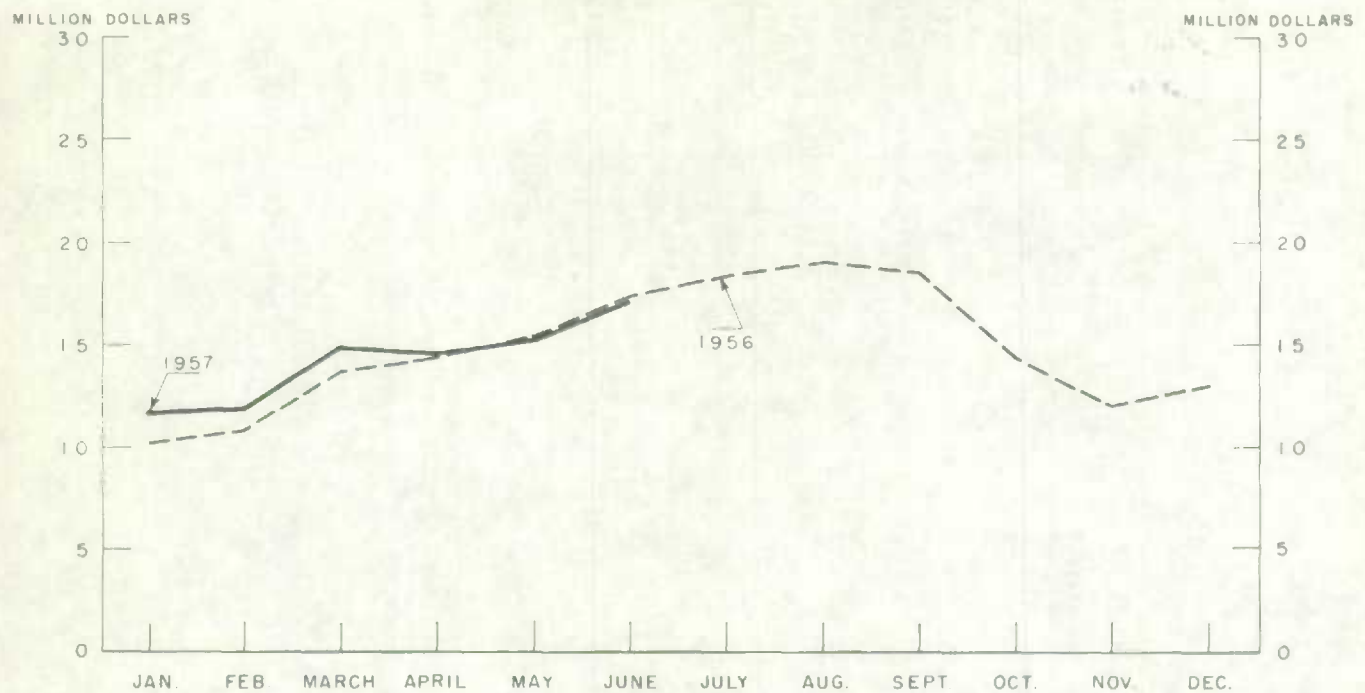
