

CIVIL AVIATION

JULY, 1957

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during July were up by 10.0 p.c., while revenue cargo dropped 36.3 p.c. as compared with July, 1956. Operating revenues decreased 5.7 p.c. to \$17,282,667 from \$18,331,278 while operating expenses dropped 2.6 p.c. to \$15,374,789 from \$15,787,186, leaving an operating income of \$1,907,878 as compared with \$2,544,092 in July of the previous year.

All revenue accounts with the exception of bulk transportation showed increases over the previous year. Passenger fares accounted for \$11,058,883 as against \$9,593,356 an increase of 15.3 p.c. Mail earnings rose to \$1,005,728 from \$915,446, freight revenue from unit toll services \$575,817 from \$494,106, excess baggage charges to \$120,027 from \$104,830, and express receipts to \$219,928 from \$219,825. Bulk transportation revenue which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service dropped 31.1 p.c. to \$3,617,132 from \$5,253,350.

As was the case last month, the two largest expense accounts both registered decreases, while the other three accounts recorded increases. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs declined to \$9,359,822 from \$9,892,739 and ground operation and maintenance charges to \$3,243,294 from \$3,442,275. In contrast, traffic charges rose to \$1,766,879 from \$1,474,241, general administration costs to \$929,538 from \$910,849 and general taxes to \$75,256 from \$67,082.

During July, Canadian air carriers transported 367,350 revenue passengers as against 334,066 in July of the previous year. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 304,389 from 265,700, while those carried in chartered service dropped to 62,961 from 68,366. Revenue passenger miles flown increased 16.1 p.c. to 169,761,812 from 146,222,901.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped 33.0 p.c. to 20,465,023 lb. from 30,528,516 lb. in July, 1956. Revenue freight declined to 16,915,738 lb. from 27,190,529 lb. and express to 870,506 lb. from 1,101,802 lb. On the other hand excess baggage carried rose to 497,193 lb. from 426,983 lb. and airmail to 2,181,586 lb. from 1,809,202 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 9,044,376 from 10,118,604. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 5,706,653 from 5,239,464, while bulk or charter service dropped to 3,337,723 from 4,879,140.

Foreign air carriers reported 56,224 passengers, 632,802 lb. of freight, and 175,234 lb. of mail flown in and out of Canada during July. Comparable figures for July, 1956 are 48,936 passengers, 693,307 lb. of freight and 166,661 lb. of mail.




