

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CIVIL AVIATION

October, 1958

Canadian air carriers transported 10.5 p.c. more revenue passengers and 25.2 p.c. more revenue cargo in October, 1958, as compared with October, 1957. Operating revenues rose 31.2 p.c. to \$17,724,091 from \$13,510,790 while operating expenses climbed only 19.3 p.c. to \$17,300,563 from \$14,499,088. As a result the operating income rose sharply to \$423,528 from a deficit of \$988,298, the fifth consecutive increase over the corresponding month in the previous year.

For the first time this year all revenue accounts registered gains over the same month in the previous year. Passenger fares rose 21.2 p.c. to \$11,450,113 from \$9,444,230; mail to \$1,046,937 from \$1,013,913, revenue from freight in unit toll service to \$798,148 from \$635,233; express to \$304,743 from \$290,712 and excess baggage to \$150,298 from \$146,876. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service almost doubled, climbing to \$2,932,560 from \$1,529,940.

Increases were also recorded in all expense accounts. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$10,200,262 from \$8,572,921; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,875,998 from \$3,328,169; traffic expenses to \$1,920,067 from \$1,597,527; general administration costs to \$1,229,212 from \$936,148 and general taxes to \$75,024 from \$64,323.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian carriers numbered 343,796 as compared with 311,201 in October, 1957. Passengers carried in unit toll service rose to 312,676 from 280,138 while those in charter service rose to 31,120 from 31,063. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 20.0 p.c. to 175,242,905 from 145,979,295.

Revenue cargo including airmail, climbed sharply to 18,052,698 lb. from 14,422,759 lb. Freight carried rose to 13,883,568 lb. from 10,402,345 lb., express to 1,180,709 lb. from 1,152,467 lb. and airmail to 2,453,270 lb. from 2,312,259 lb. while excess baggage fell to 535,151 lb. from 555,688 lb.

Total revenue miles flown increased to 7,991,498 miles from 7,052,908. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 5,934,164 miles from 5,486,458 and chartered service mileage to 2,057,334 miles from 1,566,450.

During the month Canadian air carriers distributed a total pay roll of \$6,824,199 among 15,715 employees, as against a pay roll of \$6,065,671 among 15,008 employees in October, 1957.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers amounted to 47,391 passengers, 813,764 lb. of freight and 182,357 lb. of mail. Comparable figures for October 1957, are 48,068 passengers, 810,280 lb. of freight and 166,419 lb. of mail.




