# CIVIL AVIATION

November, 1958

The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian Air Carriers in November increased by 16.2 p.c. and the volume of cargo by 2.6 p.c. in comparison with November, 1957. Operating revenues rose 14.4 p.c. to \$13,096,212 from \$11,-449,664 while operating expenses advanced only 9.0 p.c. to \$15,055,561 from \$13,-807,259. As a result the operating deficit amounted to \$1,959,349 as against \$2,357,595 in the previous November.

All revenue accounts with the exception of bulk transportation registered substantial gains over the previous November. Receipts from passenger fares rose 21.4 p.c. to \$9,457,750 from \$7,792,569, mail to \$1,056,047 from \$1,019,723, unit toll freight to \$782,928 from \$641,106, express to \$313,948 from \$261,183 and excess baggage to \$115,671 from \$102,361. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, dropped 28.7 p.c. to \$843,821 from \$1,183,648.

Expense accounts with the exception of ground operation and maintenance which dropped to \$3,270,637 from \$3,329,281 showed increases over the previous year. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$8,819,672 from \$7,928,892, traffic expenses to \$1,787,682 from \$1,607,814, general administration to \$1,102,-997 from \$876,822 and general taxes to \$74,573 from \$64,450.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during the month aggregated 286,714 as compared with 246,792 in November, 1957. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 272,690 from 234,651 and in chartered service to 14,024 from 12,141. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage was up 19.8 p.c. to 146,-119,760 from 121,967,069.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, rose to 11,998,558 lbs. from 11,689,847 in spite of a slight decrease in revenue freight to 7,852,706 lbs. from 7,930,581. In contrast express rose to 1,223,131 lbs. from 981,239, excess baggage to 449,200 lbs. from 447,074 and airmail to 2,473,521 lbs. from 2,330,953.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 6,207,161 from 5,504,754. Unit toll mileage increased to 5,329,548 miles from 4,763,059 and chartered service mileage to 877,613 miles from 741,695.

Foreign air carriers reported 34,613 passengers, 842,304 lbs. of freight and 198,488 lbs. of mail flown into or out of Canada during November. Comparable figures for November, 1957, are 37,519 passengers, 706,171 lbs. of freight and 175,113 lbs. of mail.




