December, 1958

Canadian air carriers transported 20.0 p.c. more revenue passengers and 22.1 p.c. more revenue cargo in December, 1958 than in December, 1957. Operating revenues rose 17.5 p.c. to \$15,391,614 from \$13,103,878 and operating expenses climbed 17.3 p.c. to \$17,790,185 from \$15,170,169. As a result the deficit for the month rose to \$2,398,571 from \$2,066,291.

For the second time this year all revenue accounts registered gains over the same month in the previous year. Passenger fares rose 22.5 p.c. to \$10,693,847 from \$8,731,525; mail to \$1,434,108 from \$1,354,935; revenue from freight in unit toll service to \$775,928 from \$750,264; express to \$312,661 from \$253,247 and excess baggage to \$115,310 from \$103,969. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, climbed to \$1,415,512 from \$1,344,537, an increase of 5.3 p.c.

With the exception of general taxes which dropped to \$57,644 from \$95,335, all expense accounts recorded increases. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$10,483,063 from \$8,626,395; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,740,974 from \$3,503,797; traffic expenses to \$2,004,211 from \$1,736,788 and general administration costs to \$1,504,293 from \$1,207,852.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian carriers numbered 306,742 as compared with 255,576 in December, 1957. Passengers carried in unit toll service rose to 290,629 from 239,957 while those in charter service rose to 16,113 from 15,619. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 22.6 p.c. to 162,930,228 from 132,846,861.

Revenue cargo including airmail, climbed sharply to 16,065,305 lbs. from 13,157,464 lbs. Freight carried rose to 10,556,518 lbs. from 8,313,764 lbs., express to 1,465,396 lbs. from 1,111,736 lbs., airmail to 3,604,899 lbs. from 3,325,447 lbs. and excess baggage to 438,492 lbs. from 406,517 lbs.

Total revenue miles flown increased to 7,110,467 miles from 6,191,487. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 5,880,993 miles from 5,271,098 and chartered service mileage to 1,229,474 miles from 920,389.

A fleet of 930 aircraft was utilized by Canadian air carriers during December 1958, compared with the 858 aircraft in service in December of the previous year.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers were considerably curtailed due to strikes affecting several of the trans-border carriers. In December 1958, 24,473 passengers were transported as well as 644,566 lbs. of freight and 228,533 lbs. of mail. Comparable figures for December, 1957 are 41,402 passengers, 722,723 lbs. of freight and 253,518 lbs. of mail.




