CIVIL AVIATION

February, 1958

Canadian air carriers transported 4.7 p.c. more revenue passengers but 39.1 p.c. less revenue cargo in February 1958 as compared with February 1957. Operating revenues for the month dipped 5.3 p.c. to \$11,323,861 from \$11,959,377, while operating expenses rose 4.2 p.c. to \$13,615,734 from \$13,067,780, resulting in an operating deficit for the month of \$2,291,873 as compared with \$1,108,403 one year ago.

Three of six revenue accounts showed increases while the others registered decreases. Passenger fares rose 10.0 p.c. to \$7,799,703 from \$7,089,280, mail rose to \$1,066,193 from \$998,606 and excess baggage to \$107,248 from \$96,928. In contrast, bulk transportation revenue, which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service, registered a decline of 51.6 p.c., decreasing to \$1,313,346 from \$2,713,299. Freight earnings from unit toll service dropped to \$499,483 from \$515,400 and express receipts to \$196,699 from \$238,843.

All of the expense accounts recorded substantial increases. Aircraft operation and maintenance charges rose to \$7,910,159 from \$7,723,244; ground operation and maintenance costs to \$3,083,056 from \$3,021,021; traffic expenses to \$1,553,688 from \$1,389,524; general administration costs to \$994,864 from \$873,294 and general taxes to \$73,967 from \$60,697.

Canadian air carriers transported a total of 244,134 revenue passengers during February as compared with 233,105 in February, 1957. Unit toll passengers increased to 227,656 from 207,370, while chartered service passengers decreased to 16,478 from 25,735. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 8.9 p.c. to 123,360,345 from 113,304,849.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped to 14,620,176 lb. from 24,017,056 lb. in February, 1957. This was due entirely to the sharp decline in revenue freight which fell to 10,377,093 lb. from 20,196,778 lb. On the other hand express rose to 1,055,679 lb. from 962,557 lb., excess baggage carried to 416,703 lb. from 388,847 lb. and airmail to 2,770,701 lb. from 2,468,874 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 5,720,633 from 6,572,291. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 4,654,603 from 3,987,396 but bulk or charter service dropped to 1,066,030 from 2,584,895 in February, 1957.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers in February amounted to 33,881 passengers, 651,564 lb. of freight and 159,292 lb. of mail. Comparable figures for the previous year are 40,931 passengers 731,775 lb. of freight and 179,150 lb. of mail.




