The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers declined 0.6 p.c. and the volume of cargo 18.2 p.c. in March this year as compared with March 1957. Although operating revenues dropped 4.3 p.c. to \$14,229,340 from \$14,867,030, operating expenses climbed 3.4 p.c. to \$15,306,753 from \$14,802,406 with the result that the operating deficit for the month increased to \$1,077,413 from \$64,624.

The decline in revenues was associated with sizeable decreases in receipts from charter service and from express. Bulk transportation revenue which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service, dropped 39.6 p.c. to \$2,064,400 from \$3,418,280 while express receipts declined to \$223,549 from \$265,909. All other revenue accounts registered substantial gains, receipts from passenger fares rising to \$9,389,700 from \$8,656,275, mail to \$1,145,680 from \$1,099,122, unit toll freight to \$630,269 from \$575,484 and excess baggage to \$129,995 from \$109,644.

The only expense account showing a decline from the previous year was aircraft operation and maintenance which fell slightly to \$9,021,339 from \$9,068,595. Ground operations and maintenance charges rose to \$3,369,709 from \$3,222,153; traffic expenses to \$1,751,614 from \$1,564,172, general administration costs to \$1,091,886 from \$879,438 and general taxes to \$72,205 from \$68,048.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during March totalled 284,137 as compared with 285,888 one year ago. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 263,051 from 251,896, but the number flown in chartered service dropped to 21,086 from 33,992. Revenue unit toll passenger miles increased 8.5 p.c. to 148,036,608 from 136,477,767.

Revenue cargo, including airmail dropped to 22,003,922 lb. from 26,895,787 lb., as a result of the sharp decline in revenue freight which fell to 17,577,162 lb. from 23,031,347 lb. In contrast, express rose to 1,037,033 lb. from 884,673 lb.; excess baggage to 484,580 lb. from 437,701 lb. and airmail to 2,905,147 lb. from 2,542,066 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 7,044,354 from 8,550,637. Revenue unit toll mileage dropped to 5,375,722 from 5,475,571 and bulk or charter mileage to 1,668,632 from 3,075,066.

Foreign air carriers reported 39,673 passengers, 698,988 lb. of freight and 181,975 lb. of mail flown into or out of Canada during March. Comparable figures for March 1957 are 49,820 passengers, 874,255 lb. of freight and 194,139 lb. of mail.




