## CIVIL AVIATION

April, 1958

Canadian air carriers transported 1.8 p.c. more revenue passengers but 39.8 p.c. less revenue cargo in April, 1958 than in April, 1957. Operating revenues for the month dropped 5.2 p.c. to \$13,752,998 from \$14,503,790 while operating expenses rose 1.9 p.c. to \$14,571,695 from \$14,305,161, resulting in an operating deficit for the month of \$818,697 as compared with an operating income of \$198,629 one year ago.

The decline in revenues was due to substantial decreases in receipts from charter services and express. Bulk transportation revenue which includes both passengers and cargo flown in chartered service registered a decline of 63.6 p.c., dropping to \$1,200,251 from \$3,294,682, while excess baggage dropped to \$99,808 from \$107,584. In contrast passenger fares rose 14.6 p.c. to \$10,068,438 from \$8,786,624, mail to \$1,082,953 from \$1,078,416, freight to \$566,827 from \$542,085 and express to \$216,745 from \$146,618.

With the exception of aircraft operations and maintenance, which decreased to \$8,612,884 from \$8,627,553, all expense accounts registered significant increases. Ground operation and maintenance charges rose to \$3,268,959 from \$3,133,461; traffic expenses to \$1,651,201 from \$1,584,429; general administration costs to \$964,067 from \$897,006 and general taxes to \$74,584 from \$62,712.

Canadian air carriers transported a total of 295,689 revenue passengers during April, 1958 as compared with 290,460 in April, 1957. Unit toll passengers increased to 278,158 from 258,589, but chartered service passengers decreased to 17,531, from 31,871. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 17.7 p.c. to 157,037,486 from 133,406,749.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped to 13,239,279 lb. from 21,986,766 lb. in April, 1957. This sharp decline was largely a result of the decrease in revenue freight which fell to 9,406,644 lb. from 18,290,181 lb. Excess baggage carried also fell slightly to 410,584 lb. from 452,686 lb. On the other hand express rose to 936,881 lb. from 830,246 lb. and airmail to 2,485,170 lb. from 2,413,653 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 6,628,389 from 8,149,975. Revenue unit toll mileage dropped to 5,411,740 from 6,276,503 and bulk or charter service to 1,216,649 from 1,873,472.

During the month Canadian air carriers distributed a total payroll of \$6,025,043 among 14,957 employees, as compared with a payroll of \$5,876,669 among 14,694 employees in April, 1957.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers in April amounted to 46,035 passengers, 769,744 lb. of freight and 185,283 lb. of mail. Comparable figures for April, 1957 are 50,385 passengers, 762,994 lb. of freight and 173,696 lb. of mail.

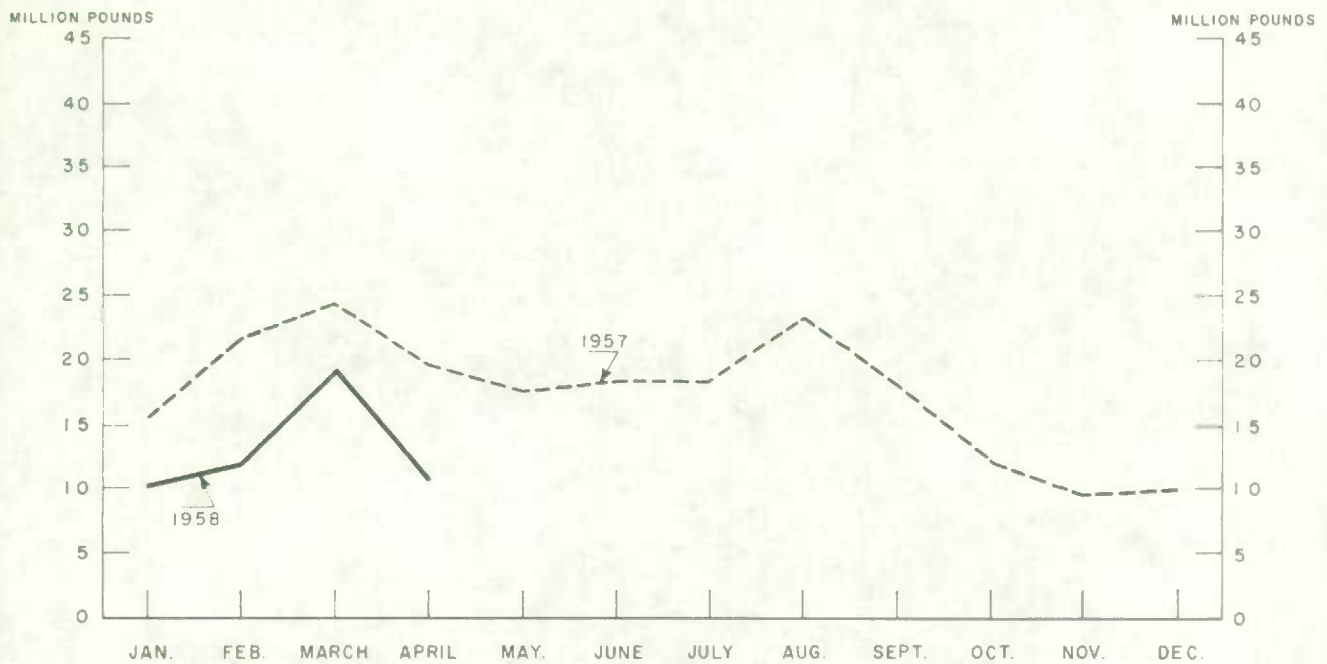
