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CIVIL AVIATION

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The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers in May increased by 4.5 p.c. while the volume of cargo handled declined 24.5 p.c. as compared with May, 1957. Although operating revenues rose 1.8 p.c. to \$15,438,163 from \$15,161,714, operating expenses climbed 6.8 p.c. to \$15,375,210 from \$14,400,919 resulting in operating income of only \$62,953 this May as compared with \$760,795 one year earlier.

Substantial gains in revenue from passenger fares and express more than off-set decreases in the other income accounts. Receipts from passenger fares rose 15.5 p.c. to \$10,985,005 and from express 9.3 p.c. to \$245,770. In contrast, revenue from mail dropped to \$1,034,087 from \$1,065,858, freight to \$605,668 from \$643,958 and excess baggage to \$114,616 from \$117,145. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, dropped 43.3 p.c. to \$1,690,355 from \$2,980,829.

The only expense account registering a decline from the previous year was general taxes which dropped to \$64,438 from \$69,097. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$9,078,139 from \$8,692,361, ground operation and maintenance to \$3,273,042 from \$3,147,137, traffic expenses to \$1,914,558 from \$1,627,316 and general administration costs to \$1,045,033 from \$865,008.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during May aggregated 330,629 as compared with 316,460 one year ago. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 297,536 from 274,659, while the number flown in chartered service dropped to 33,093 from 41,801. Revenue unit toll passenger miles increased 15.2 p.c. to 167,440,718 from 145,390,423.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped to 15,052,948 lb. from 19,936,398 lb. due mainly to a sharp decline in revenue freight which fell to 11,109,909 lb. from 16,145,511 lb. Excess baggage also declined, dropping to 452,755 lb. from 486,042 lb. Increased volumes were reported for express up to 1,046,283 lb. and airmail up to 2,-444,001 lb. from 2,439,417 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 7,365,785 miles from 7,762,740. Revenue unit toll mileage increased to 5,678,268 from 5,277,156 but bulk or charter mileage dropped to 1,687,517 from 2,485,584.

Foreign air carriers reported 44,214 passengers, 812,591 lb. of freight and 179,-509 lb. of mail flown into or out of Canada during May. Comparable figures for May, 1957 are 51,589 passengers, 934,955 lb. of freight and 180,442 lb. of mail.




