

JUNE, 1958

Canadian air carriers transported 8.8 p.c. more revenue passengers but 8.5 p.c. less revenue cargo in June 1958 as compared with June 1957. Operating revenues rose 8.1 p.c. to \$18,464,635 from \$17,076,299 and operating expenses 7.5 p.c. to \$16,142,627 from \$15,021,937. The resulting rise in operating income to \$2,-322,008 from \$2,054,362 was the first monthly increase over the previous year recorded in 1958.

All revenue accounts with the exception of bulk transportation registered substantial gains over the previous June. Receipts from passenger fares rose 16.6 p.c. to \$12,928,401 from \$11,090,080, mail revenue advanced to \$1,008,007 from \$984,676, freight to \$652,722 from \$539,749, express to \$263,843 from \$237,112 and excess baggage to \$145,947 from \$117,720. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, dropped 21.8 p.c. to \$2,583,329 from \$3,305,136.

Increases were recorded in all expense accounts. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$9,644,942 from \$9,174,663, ground operations and maintenance to \$3,369,242 from \$3,117,851, traffic expenses to \$1,985,590 from \$1,751,967, general administration costs to \$1,052,508 from \$898,208 and general taxes to \$90,345 from \$79,248.

Revenue passengers totalled 383,893 as compared with 352,940 in June 1957. A rise in unit toll passengers of 14.3 p.c. to 337,145 from 294,981 was partially offset by a decrease in chartered service passengers to 46,748 from 57,959. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage was up 16.8 p.c. to 199,152,320 miles from 170,577,399.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, declined to 18,819,110 lb. from 20,563,016 lb. The decline was associated with a drop in freight carried which fell to 14,-951,831 lb. from 16,926,525 lb. Express carried rose to 994,751 lb. from 967,036 lb., excess baggage to 532,963 lb. from 498,541 lb. and airmail to 2,339,565 lb. from 2,170,914 lb.

Total revenue miles flown decreased to 8,715,441 miles from 10,121,968. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 6,323,472 miles from 5,580,567, but bulk or chartered service mileage dropped to 2,391,969 miles from 4,541,401.

During the month Canadian air carriers distributed a total pay roll of \$6,-458,832 among 15,174 employees, as against a payroll of \$6,050,538 among 15,098 employees in June, 1957.

The Canadian operations of foreign air carriers in June amounted to 53,186 passengers, 786,530 lb. of freight and 166,759 lb. of mail. Comparable figures for June, 1957, are 58,953 passengers, 797,223 lb. of freight and 170,494 lb. of mail.




