

The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers in July increased by 12.5 p.c. while the volume of cargo handled was virtually unchanged as compared with July, 1957. Operating revenues rose 8.9 p.c. to \$18,813,271 from \$17,282,667 and operating expenses climbed 6.5 p.c. to \$16,370,300 from \$15,374,789. Thus the operating income rose to \$2,442,971 from \$1,907,878, the second consecutive increase over the corresponding month of the previous year.

All revenue accounts, with the exception of bulk transportation, registered substantial gains over the previous July. Receipts from passenger fares rose 18.5 p.c. to \$13,105,122 from \$11,058,883, mail revenue advanced to \$1,010,345 from \$1,005,728, unit toll freight to \$588,980 from \$575,817, express to \$263,007 from \$219,928 and excess baggage to \$134,464 from \$120.027. On the other hand revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, dropped 21.1 p.c. to \$2,852,501 from \$3,617,132.

The only expense account registering a decline from the previous year was general taxes which dropped to \$68,140 from \$75,256. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$9,655,117 from \$9,359,822, ground operation and maintenance to \$3,544,190 from \$3,243,294, traffic expenses to \$1,979,984 from \$1,766,879, and general administration costs to \$1,122,869 from \$929,538.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during July aggregated 413,154, as compared with 367,350 in July, 1957. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 361,145 from 304,389, while the number flown in chartered service dropped to 52,009 from 62,961. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage was up 27.0 p.c. to 215,607,054 from 169,761,812.

Revenue cargo including airmail declined slightly to 20,379,875 lb. from 20,465,023 lb. The decline was due entirely to the drop in revenue freight which fell to 16,429,535 lb. from 16,915,738 lb. In contrast express carried rose to 1,050,289 lb. from 870,506 lb., excess baggage to 532,972 lb. from 497,193 lb. and airmail to 2,367,079 lb. from 2,181,586 lb.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 9,855,482 miles from 9,044,376. A rise in unit toll mileage to 6,785,500 from 5,706,653 was partially offset by a decrease in chartered service mileage to 3,069,982 from 3,337,723.

A fleet of 923 aircraft was utilized by Canadian air carriers during July 1957, compared with the 865 aircraft in service in July of the previous year.

Foreign air carriers reported 56,068 passengers, 703,568 lb. of freight and 175,163 lb. of mail flown into or out of Canada during July. Comparable figures for July, 1957, are 56,224 passengers, 632,802 lb. of freight and 175,234 lb. of mail.




