

CIVIL AVIATION

September, 1958

The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian Air carriers in September increased by 10.3 p.c., but the volume of cargo handled decreased 4.6 p.c. in comparison with September, 1957. Operating revenues rose 12.6 p.c. to \$18,373,721 from \$16,318,945, while operating expenses climbed only 8.1 p.c. to \$16,133,569 from \$14,919,878. Thus the operating income rose to \$2,240,152 from \$1,399,067, the fourth consecutive increase over the corresponding month in the previous year.

All revenue accounts, with the exception of bulk transportation, registered substantial gains over the previous September. Receipts from passenger fares rose 17.5 p.c. to \$12,836,572 from \$10,922,607, mail to \$980,765 from \$969,858, unit toll freight to \$652,860 from \$613,533, express to \$283,196 from \$219,838 and excess baggage to \$166,567 from \$143,466. On the other hand, revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, dropped 6.9 p.c. to \$2,487,621 from \$2,671,964.

Expense accounts also showed increases over the previous year. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$9,585,551 from \$8,925,066, ground operation and maintenance to \$3,568,244 from \$3,319,104, traffic expenses to \$1,874,684 from \$1,670,948, general administration costs to \$1,024,989 from \$941,584, and general taxes to \$80,101 from \$63,176

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during September aggregated 385,180 as compared with 349,255. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 341,932 from 300,653, while the number in chartered service dropped to 43,248 from 48,602. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage was up 19.4 p.c. to 200,170,647 from 167,713,405.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped to 19,392,150 lbs. from 20,330,332 lbs. This decline was due entirely to the drop in revenue freight which fell to 15,233,472 lbs. from 16,596,501 lbs. In contrast express carried rose to 1,191,097 lbs. from 953,243 lbs, excess baggage to 627,964 lbs. from 625,318 lbs. and airmail to 2,339,617 lbs. from 2,155,270 lbs.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 8,728,748 from 8,273,589. A rise in unit toll mileage to 6,212,208 from 5,626,086 was partially offset by a decrease in chartered service mileage, which fell to 2,516,540 from 2,647,503.

Foreign air carriers reported 51,715 passengers, 819,846 lbs. of freight and 193,945 lbs. of mail flown into or out of Canada during September. Comparable figures for September, 1957, are 54,956 passengers, 799,524 lbs. of freight and 177,883 lbs. of mail.




