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

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CIVIL AVIATION

December, 1959

Canadian air carriers transported 15.2 per cent more revenue passengers and 4.7 per cent more revenue cargo in December, 1959 than in December, 1958. Operating revenues rose 6.3 per cent to \$16,353,792 from \$15,391,614, while operating expenses rose 5.6 per cent to \$18,780,210 from \$17,790,185. The operating loss for the month increased to \$2,426,418 from \$2,398,571 and net income after provision for income taxes and other charges, registered a deficit of \$2,377,382 as compared with one of \$2,641,425 in December, 1958.

All revenue accounts, except bulk transportation, recorded substantial gains over the corresponding month of the previous year. Passenger fares rose 11.2 per cent to \$11,889,713 from \$10,693,847; mail revenue advanced to \$1,481,569 from \$1,434,108; revenue from freight carried in unit toll service to \$881,531 from \$775,928; express to \$466,940 from \$312,661 and excess baggage to \$131,562 from \$115,310. In contrast, revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, decreased 8.9 per cent to \$1,289,362 from \$1,415,512.

All expense accounts, except aircraft operation and maintenance, registered increases this month in com arison with December, 1958. Ground operation and maintenance charges rose to \$4,190,354 from \$3,740,974; traffic expenses to \$2,-401,793 from \$2,004,211; general administration costs to \$1,811,194 from \$1,504,293 and general taxes to 108,177 from \$57,644. Aircraft operation and maintenance expenses however, decreased to \$10,268,692 from \$10,483,063.

The total number of revenue passengers transported by Canadian carriers aggregated 353,306 as compared with 306,742 in December, 1958. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 337,304 from 290,629 while those in charter service decreased slightly to 16,002 from 16,113. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 9.6 per cent to 178,497,999 from 162,930,228.

The total volume of revenue goods transported, including airmail, increased to 16,813,757 lbs. from 16,065,305. Freight carried rose to 10,629,570 lbs. from 10,556,518; express to 1,819,068 lbs. from 1,465,396; excess baggage to 487,492 and airmail to 3,877,180 lbs. from 3,604,899.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 7,579,506 from 7,110,467. Unit toll mileage increased to 6,428,443 from 5,880,993 while charter service mileage dropped slightly to 1,151,063 from 1,229,474.

During the month under review, foreign air carriers licensed to operate in Canada transported 49,751 revenue passengers, 1,105,379 lbs. of revenue freight and 302,600 lbs. of mail as compared with 24,473 revenue passengers, 605,072 lbs. of revenue freight and 228,533 lbs. of mail in December, 1958.


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
