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

CIVIL AVIATION

February, 1959

Canadian air carriers transported 17.0 p.c. more revenue passengers and 10.8 p.c. more revenue freight in February, 1959, than in February, 1958. Operating revenues rose 20.0 p.c. to \$13,586,672 from \$11,323,861 and operating expenses climbed 17.0 p.c. to \$15,925,299 from \$13,615,734. As a result the deficit for the month rose slightly to \$2,338,627 from \$2,291,873.

Substantial gains were recorded for all revenue accounts as compared with the previous February. Passenger fares rose 21.3 p.c. to \$9,463,980 from \$7,799,703; mail to \$1,109,471 from \$1,066,193; revenue from freight carried in unit toll service to \$649,129 from \$499,483; express to \$249,771 from \$196,699 and excess baggage to \$114,449 from \$107,248. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service increased by 16.2 p.c. to \$1,525,782 from \$1,313,346.

With the exception of general taxes which dropped to \$66,088 from \$73,967, all expense accounts registered increases. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$9,423,940 from \$7,910,159; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,505,153 from \$3,083,056; traffic expense to \$1,788,411 from \$1,553,688 and general administration costs to \$1,139,707 from \$994,864.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian carriers numbered 285,630 as compared with 244,134 in February, 1958. Passengers carried in unit toll service rose to 265,654 from 227,656 while those in charter service increased to 19,976 from 16,478. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 20.7 p.c. to 148,858,664 from 123,360,345.

Revenue cargo including airmail totalled 16,198,662 lbs. as compared with 14,620,176 lbs. Freight carried rose to 11,657,205 lbs. from 10,377,093 lbs., express to 1,306,045 lbs. from 1,055,679 lbs., excess baggage to 443,621 lbs. from 416,703 lbs. and airmail to 2,791,791 lbs. from 2,770,701 lbs.

Total revenue miles flown increased to 6,752,820 from 5,720,633. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 5,334,470 miles from 4,654,603 and chartered service mileage to 1,413,350 miles from 1,066,030.

During the month under review, foreign air carriers licensed to operate in Canada transported 37,994 passengers, 909,531 lbs. of freight and 200,355 lbs. of mail as compared with 33,881 passengers, 651,564 lbs. of freight and 159,292 lbs. of mail during the corresponding period in 1958.


