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CIVIL AVIATION

The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers in March increased 21.2 p.c. and the volume of cargo 4.9 p.c. in comparison with March 1958. Operating revenues rose 17.5 p.c. to \$16,725,039 from \$14,229,340 while operating expenses advanced 13.2 p.c. to \$17,327,697 from \$15,306,753. As a result the operating deficit dropped to \$602,658 as against \$1,077,413 in March of the previous year.

All revenue accounts registered substantial gains over the previous March. Receipts from passenger fares rose 24.4 p.c. to \$11,678,885 from \$9,389,700; mail to \$1,202,370 from \$1,145,680; unit toll freight to \$717,993 from \$630,269; express to \$255,863 from \$223,549 and excess baggage to \$134,024 from \$129,995. Revenue from bulk transportation which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, was up 1.4 p.c. to \$2,093,124 from \$2,064,400.

Increases were also recorded in all expense accounts. Aircraft operation and maintenance rose to \$10,476,132 from \$9,021,339; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,611,884 from \$3,369,709; traffic expenses to \$1,985,677 from \$1,751,614; general administration to \$1,172,551 from \$1,091,886 and general taxes to \$81,453 from \$72,205.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers during the month aggregated 344,301 as compared with 284,137 in March, 1958. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 320,275 from 263,051 and in chartered service to 24,026 from 21,086. Revenue unit toll passenger mileage rose 23.9 p.c. to 183,385,529 from 148,036,608.

Revenue cargo including airmail rose to 23,073,392 lbs. from 22,003,922 in March, 1958. Revenue freight increased to 18,382,358 lbs. from 17,577,162; express to 1,239,238 lbs. from 1,037,033 and airmail to 2,970,556 lbs. from 2,905,147. On the other hand excess baggage carried dropped slightly to 481,240 lbs. from 484,580.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 8,038,730 from 7,044,354. Unit toll mileage increased to 6,126,056 from 5,375,722 and chartered service mileage to 1,912,674 from 1,668,632.

During the month under review, foreign air carriers licensed to operate in Canada transported 45,414 passengers, 957,554 lbs. of freight and 209,489 lbs. of mail, as compared with 39,673 passengers, 678,988 lbs. of freight and 181,975 lbs. of mail during the corresponding period of 1958.

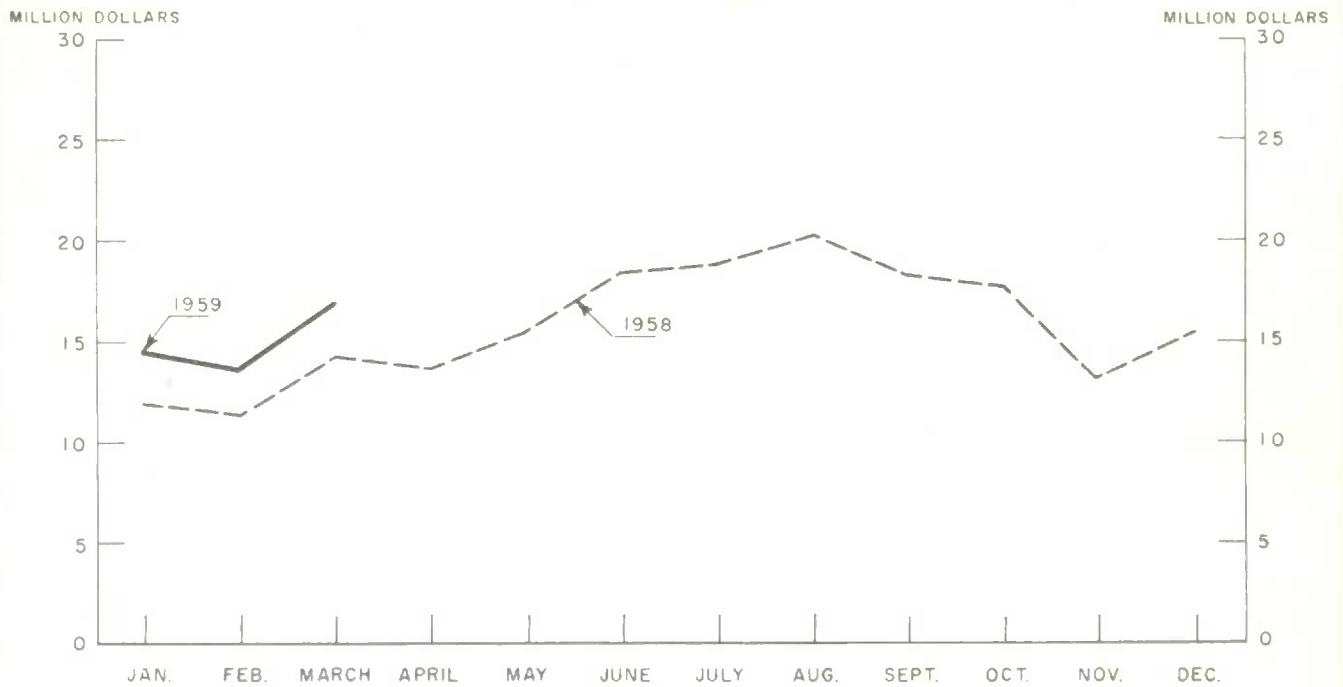
