

#### CIVIL AVIATION

#### June, 1959

Canadian Air Carriers transported 16.2 p.c. more revenue passengers and 21.5 p.c. more revenue cargo in June 1959, than in June, 1958. Operating revenues rose 17.0 p.c. to \$21,612,475 from \$18,464,635, reaching an all time high for a single month. Although operating expenses increased by 19.0 p.c., to \$19,212,888 from \$16,142,627, the operating income for the month advanced to \$2,399,587 from \$2,322,008.

For the sixth successive month all revenue accounts registered substantial gains over the corresponding month of the previous year. Passenger fares rose 14.2 p.c. to \$14,765,987 from \$12,928,401, mail to \$1,034,749 from \$1,008,007; revenue from freight in unit toll service to \$744,998 from \$652,722, express to \$340,698 from \$263,843 and excess baggage to \$168,589 from \$145,947. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service climbed sharply to \$3,472,167 from \$2,583,329, an increase of 34.4 p.c.

All expense accounts recorded increases this month in comparison with June, 1958. Aircraft operation and maintenance expenses rose to \$11,729,743 from \$9,644,942; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,823,214 from \$3,369,242; traffic expenses to \$2,297,641 from \$1,985,590; general administration costs to \$1,265,326 from \$1,052,508 and general taxes to \$96,964 from \$90,345.

Revenue passengers transported by Canadian air carriers numbered 446,089 as compared with 383,893 in June 1958. Passengers carried in unit toll service rose to 378,494 from 337,145 while those in charter service rose to 67,595 from 46,748. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 13.4 p.c. to 225,886,770 from 199,152,320.


Revenue cargo including airmail climbed to 22,868,234 lbs. from 18,819,110, as each category of goods flown increased sharply over June of 1958. Freight carried rose to 17,998,299 lbs. from 14,951,831, express to 1,691,057 lbs. from 994,751, excess baggage to 646,199 lbs. from 532,963 and airmail to 2,532,679 lbs. from 2,339,565.


Total revenue miles flown increased to 10,421,706 from 8,715,441. Revenue unit toll mileage rose to 6,884,192 from 6,323,472 and charter service mileage to 3,537,514 from 2,391,969.

During June 1959, foreign air carriers licensed to operate in Canada transported 63,735 revenue passengers, 965,487 lbs. of revenue freight and 234,936 lbs. of mail as compared with 53,186 revenue passengers, 742,408 lbs. of revenue freight and 166,759 lbs. of mail during the corresponding period in 1958.

### Definitions (Non-scheduled Carriers)

Class "B" - Companies with annual gross revenues of \$100,000 and over. Class "C" - Annual gross revenues of between \$25,000 and \$100,000. Class "D" - Annual gross revenues of less than \$25,000.
