

CIVIL AVIATION

July, 1959

The number of revenue passengers flown by Canadian air carriers in July increased 13.5 per cent and the volume of cargo transported rose 23.3 per cent in comparison with July, 1958. Operating revenues rose 17.1 per cent from \$18,813,271 to \$22,026,808, an all time high for a single month. Although operating expenses increased 17.9 per cent to \$19,305,920 from \$16,370,300, operating income rose 11.4 per cent to \$2,720,888 from \$2,442,971 in July of the previous year.

For the seventh successive month all revenue accounts registered substantial gains over the corresponding month of the previous year. Passenger fares rose 14.5 per cent to \$15,010,040 from \$13,105,122; mail revenue advanced to \$1,050,306 from \$1,010,345; revenue from freight carried in unit toll service rose to \$751,-671 from \$588,980; express to \$357,910 from \$263,007 and excess baggage to \$149,-541 from \$134,464. Revenue from bulk transportation, which includes both cargo and passengers flown in chartered service, advanced 25.9 per cent to \$3,589,925 from \$2,852,501.

All expense accounts recorded increases this month in comparison with July, 1958. Aircraft operation and maintenance charges rose to \$11,742,751 from \$9,655,-117; ground operation and maintenance to \$3,932,826 from \$3,544,190; traffic expenses to \$2,315,499 from \$1,979,984; general administration costs to \$1,227,968 from \$1,122,869 and general taxes rose to \$86,876 from \$68,140.

The number of revenue passengers transported by Canadian carriers aggregated 468,935 as compared with 413,154 in July, 1958. Passengers flown in unit toll service increased to 392,378 from 361,145 and in chartered service to 76,557 from 52,009. Revenue unit toll passenger miles rose 8.8 per cent to 234,662,682 from 215,607,054.

The total volume of revenue goods, including airmail, rose to 25,129,499 lbs. from 20,379,875 lbs., as all types of goods carried recorded increases in comparison with July, 1958. Revenue freight advanced to 20,206,832 lbs. from 16,429,535; express to 1,918,388 lbs. from 1,050,289; excess baggage to 611,292 lbs. from 532,972 and airmail to 2,392,987 lbs. from 2,367,079.

Total revenue miles flown rose to 11,108,876 miles from 9,855,482. Unit toll mileage increased to 7,182,218 from 6,785,500 and chartered service mileage to 3,926,658 from 3,069,982 miles.

During the month under review, foreign air carriers licensed to operate in Canada transported 65,903 revenue passengers, 970,248 lbs. of revenue freight and 240,002 lbs. of mail, as compared with 56,068 revenue passengers, 663,743 lbs. of revenue freight and 175,163 lbs. of mail during the corresponding period in 1958.




