Operating revenues of Canadian scheduled air carriers were \$2,011,525 during October compared with \$2,138,550 in September and \$1,828,681 in October, 1946. Expenses have been rising at a faster pace, totalling \$2,162,107 in the month under review as against \$2,124,006 in September and \$1,884,222 in the same month of 1946. The balance shows a net operating deficit of over \$150,000 in October compared with \$55,541 one year previous. Non-scheduled carriers reported considerably increased activity with revenues at \$539,736 as against \$176,837 in October 1946 and expenses at \$475,126 compared with \$152,564, leaving net revenues of \$64,610 for the month, an improvement of nearly \$40,400 over October of the preceding year. Mon-scheduled aircraft are coming into greater use by game hunters in the fall months and for northern development.

The net total of passengers carried by scheduled carriers in scheduled operations was 47,955, an increase of 3,565 or 7.5 p.c. over October 1946, with 2,071 of the advance credited to international routes. Traffic originating on foreign lines international service dropped from 24,288 to 18,608 passengers, a decline of over 23 p.c.

An increase was indicated in the average number of passengers per aircraft mile on Canadian scheduled carriers at 11.8 as against 10.0 in October, 1946, while the average passage rose from 373 to 395 miles.

The ratio of revenue passenger miles to available seat miles registered a decline from 68.2 to 66.5 on reporting Canadian scheduled carriers while international routes showed a minor improvement at 62.4 for the month as against 61.3 in October, 1946.

Total revenue freight carried by all companies reporting during October increased from a net 2,842,424 lbs. to 3,167,017 or by 11.4 p.c. from one year previous, while mail ton miles were 135,650 compared with 129,377 up 4.4 p.c.

The number of employees declined from 6,146 to 5,512 but pay roll registered a minor increase at \$1,138,086 as against \$1,121,663. The average thus rose from \$1,825 to nearly \$2,085 per employee over the twalve months.

Cumulative totals for the first ten months indicate that total revenues of Canadian scheduled carriers rose from \$17,328,515 in 1946 to \$18,339,461 while operating expenses were up from \$17,203,261 to \$20,492,104 in the same comparison leaving a loss of \$2,152,643 compared with net revenues of \$125,254 to the end of October ir the preceding year. Non-scheduled carriers, however, retained reduced net revenues with revenues at \$5,754,034 compared with \$1,243,513, operating expenses of \$5,588,047 against \$1,041,546 and resulting net revenues of \$165,987 in the first ten months down from \$201,967 in 1946 when a much smaller volume of business was carried.
