CIVIL AVIATION

SUMMARY OF MONTHLY REPORTS

(Preliminary, 1947)

The present report is a first compilation of the monthly data for scheduled and other Canadian carriers as given in the reports issued for each month of 1947. A more complete and revised report based on annual reports from the companies giving general balance sheets, income accounts, labour and accident statistics, etc. appears later in the year. Some adjustments in the published 1946 figures have been required to make them comparable with 1947. The M. & C. Aviation Company was transferred in January, 1947 to non-scheduled. Statistics on the overseas service of Trans-Canada Airlines are not included in Bureau reports on civil aviation.

The four scheduled Canadian air carriers - Canadian Pacific, Maritime Central, Trans-Canada and Central Northern transported 582,102 revenue passengers during 1947, an increase of 36,254 or 6.6 p.c. above 1946. Of these 122,015 were carried on International routes compared with 81,616 in the preceding year. Foreign (U.S.) lines business, however, decreased from 244,838 in 1946 to 200,019 passengers. The grand total of revenue passengers on all routes during 1947 was 893,579 against 855,381 in the previous year, a gain of 4.4 p. c. This compares favorably with the decline of 6 p.c. in the total revenue passengers carried by the railways, which stood at 38,123,000 against 40,488,000 in 1946. Revenue and non-revenue freight carried declined on scheduled lines but that of other carriers increased from 4,262,724 to 14,871,002 lbs. The volume and mileage of mail transported was improved by the post office experimental flights with first class mail, and ton miles were 1,574,424 on scheduled carriers compared with 1,480,821 in the preceding year.

Total revenues of Canadian carriers rose from \$21,987,989 in 1946 to \$26,416,853, up some 20 p.c., but operating expenses sourced 26.7 p. c. from \$22,777,440 to \$28,855,079 with all items increasing. The resulting loss on operations rose from a debit of \$789,451 in 1946 to \$2,438,226 and is exclusive of interest on stocks and funded debt as well as other income credits and debits. Expenses averaged 109.2 p.c. of revenues and only in the months of August and September did revenues actually exceed expenses, (December revenues having been distorted by T.C.A. year end adjustments).

The revenue passenger load factor on scheduled Canadian lines dropped to 60.9 p.c. against 74.0 in 1946 while foreign lines serving Canada reported a load factor of only 43.7 against 61.5 p.c. in the preceding year. Efforts are being made to replace this unused lifting capacity with mail or cargo.

The number of employees of all Canadian carriers increased from 5,413 to 5,606, up 3.5 p.c. and pay roll rose from \$12,054,973 to \$13,163,998 or by 9.4 p.c.

Reporting carriers consumed 13,820,101 gallons of gasoline and 182,786 gallons of lubricating oil during 1947 compared with 11,278,759 and 149,829 gallons respectively in 1946. The number of aircraft listed on scheduled flights was 107 while 278 are reported from other Canadian operators. Nearly 94 p.c. of flights scheduled were flown during the year. Both the speed and size of planes in use increased.
