Aircraft Movement Statistics
Airports without Air Traffic Control Towers

This issue of the Bulletin is the second in a series of releases on aircraft movements at selected airports without air traffic control towers.

The report consists of three tables reflecting the complexity of the original reports. Level 1 airports provide the same detail as airports with control towers. Level 2 airports report on a daily basis but in less detail. Level 3 airports submit a weekly report.

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Because the statistics shown are from tabulations at an early stage in the production of detailed tables, some slight modifications may be made at a later date. Corrections should not have any appreciable effect on the magnitudes shown.
