## Civil Aviation - January 1969 Canadian Commercial Air Carriers Except Group V

Monthly reports from the approximately 125 Canadian air carriers having more than \$150,000 gross annual flying revenues have been compiled and the results shown in tabular form on the opposite side of the page.

The established pattern of over 90 per cent of the unit toll services activity being performed by the six major carriers continued. However, in the charter flying market the smaller airlines asserted their importance both in passenger and goods traffic.

Major increases were reported in January for unit toll goods and charter passengers and higher revenues reflect this increased traffic.
