Aircraft Movement Statistics Airports with DOT Air Traffic Control Towers

During July 1969, aircraft activity at airports with Department of Transport control towers amounted to 491,499 movements, 36,669 more than during July 1968. Itinerant movements totalled 198,624 or 16,873 more. Local flights accounted for 282,948 movements, 18,415 higher than during July of last year. Simulated approaches were 1,381 higher with 9,927.
