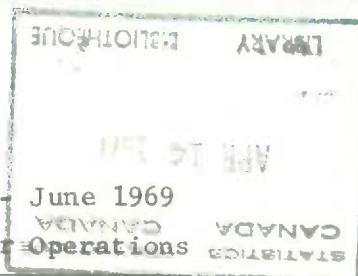

Scheduled Carrier Operations



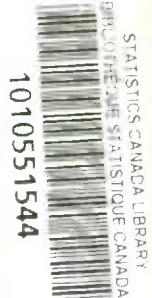
