Civil Aviation - July 1969 Scheduled Carrier Operations

Preliminary figures for the six Canadian carriers performing scheduled air services have been compiled and the results shown on the opposite side of the page.

Note that additional information in the form of charter service passenger-miles and charter service goods ton-miles has been introduced into this issue of the Service Bulletin. As can be seen from the year-to-date comparative figures charter operations, especially for the regional carriers, have grown remarkably in percentage terms. However, figures for charter operations are still only a small fraction of those for unit toll services. The number of charter passenger-miles is less than 1/10 that shown for unit toll.
