PRELIMINARY REPORT

1958

This report presents a summary of monthly statements supplied by Canadian air carriers and by foreign air carriers engaged in international service to and from Canadian airports. A more comprehensive annual report based on audited yearly statements will appear later under the title "Civil Aviation 1958". Figures shown in this report are subject to revision.

Operating revenues of Canadian air carriers rose 5.3 p.c. in 1958 to \$200,146,709 from \$190,082,035 in 1957 and operating expenses increased by 5.2 p.c. to \$199,240,633 from \$189,452,759. The resulting operating surplus of \$906,076 compares with \$629,276 in 1957. Scheduled air carriers, with operating revenues of \$164,843,737 and expenses of \$164,986,462, reported an operating deficit of \$142,725, while non-scheduled carriers with revenues of \$35,302,972 and expenses of \$34,254,171 showed a surplus of \$1,048,801.

With the exception of revenue from passengers and cargo carried in chartered service, all revenue accounts registered substantial increases. Revenue from unit toll passenger fares rose 16.8 p.c. to \$131,212,217 from \$112,295,278, mail revenue rose 2.5 p.c. to \$12,979,179; revenue from freight carried in unit toll service was up 6.1 p.c. to \$7,770,701; express revenue rose 7.2 p.c. to \$3,141,824 and excess baggage increased 7.5 p.c. to \$1,536,401. Bulk transportation revenue dropped 25.8 p.c. to \$30,232,031 from \$40,753,733 in 1957.

All individual expense accounts showed increases over the previous year. Aircraft operation and maintenance costs totalled \$118,312,532 as compared with \$115,032,598 in 1957, while ground operation and maintenance charges advanced to \$43,401,858 from \$41,350,781. Traffic expenses rose to \$22,272,688 from \$19,714,092, general administration costs to \$14,372,589 from \$12,495,042 and general taxes to \$880,966 from \$860,246.

Canadian air carriers transported a total of 4,021,721 revenue passengers during the year, an increase of 295,118 or 7.9 p.c. over the 3,726,603 carried one year earlier. This year 3,599,175 passengers were transported in unit toll service as against 3,217,266 in 1957, while passengers carried in bulk or chartered service totalled 422,546 as compared with 509,337 in the previous year. Passenger miles flown in revenue unit toll service rose 17.1 p.c. to 2,036,147,130 from 1,737,582,244, the increase indicating a slightly longer average trip in addition to increased passenger volume.

Revenue cargo, including airmail, dropped 13.2 p.c. to 222,391,217 lb. from 256,149,122 lb. in 1957. Revenue freight fell sharply to 171,484,116 lb. from 238,084,104 lb. and excess baggage declined to 5,904,809 lb. from 5,943,649 lb. In contrast, express rose to 13,620,243 lb. from 12,121,369 lb. and airmail to 31.382,049 lb. from 29,263,675 lb.

During the year Canadian air carriers flew a total of 95,747,996 miles. Revenue unit toll mileage aggregated 69,429,851 miles as compared with 64,472,262 in 1957 but bulk or charter service mileage dropped to 26,318,145 miles from 36,743,407.

Statistics received from foreign air carriers operating into and out of Canada show that 532,314 passengers, 9,169,922 lb. of freight and 2,240,172 lb. of mail were carried in 1958. Comparable figures for 1957 are 593,317 passengers, 9,399,322 lb. of freight and 2,149,829 lb. of mail.




