CAR LOADINGS

Twenty-fourth Week ended June 16th, 1934

Car loadings for the week ended June 16th increased from 42,933 cars for the previous week to 44,482 cars and were heavier than in 1933 by 3,911 cars. Grain increased by 755 cars over the previous week, miscellaneous freight was up by 521 cars, ore by 245 cars, pulpwood by 226 cars and other forest products by 224 cars. Compared with last year's loadings grain was down by 3,366 cars and live stock by 93 cars, but all other commodities showed increases. Miscellaneous freight increased by 2,363 cars, coal by 2,314 cars, pulpwood by 944 cars, ore by 795 cars, lumber by 341 cars, pulp and paper by 212 cars and other forest products by 213 cars.


Total loadings in the eastern division amounted to 30,976 cars, an increase of 483 cars over the previous week and 6,827 cars over last year's, but in the western division, due almost entirely to light grain shipments, the total of 13,506 cars was 2,916 cars below last year's. Compared with the previous week, however, a gain was recorded of 1,066 cars, grain increasing by 745 cars, ore by 236 cars and other forest products by 190 cars.


