CAR LOADINGS

No. 26

Twenty-sixth Week ended June 30th, 1934.

Car loadings for the week ended June 30th amounted to 46,645 cars, which was 2,209 cars over the previous week's total and 11,356 cars over last year's. This latter comparison is affected by the holiday, July 1st, being on Saturday of the 26th week in 1933. The index number however, after adjustment for holidays etc., was 73.97 as against 64.96 last year, and 70.25 for the previous week this year. Grain loadings increased by 426 cars over the previous week's, miscellaneous freight was heavier by 825 cars, merchandise by 618 cars, other forest products by 254 cars and ore by 190 cars.

With increases of 423 cars in grain, 328 cars in miscellaneous, 213 cars in ore, 174 cars in merchandise, 134 cars in live stock and 109 cars in other forest products, the total in the western division of 15,823 cars was 1,443 cars above the previous week's.

The eastern division showed heavy loading in miscellaneous, merchandise and coal and total loadings of 30,822 cars were 766 cars above the previous week's and 8,902 cars above the total for the corresponding week last year.

For the first 26 weeks this year total loadings amounted to 1,094,453 cars as against 900,680 cars in 1933, 1,076,846 cars in 1932 and 1,258,940 cars in 1931.

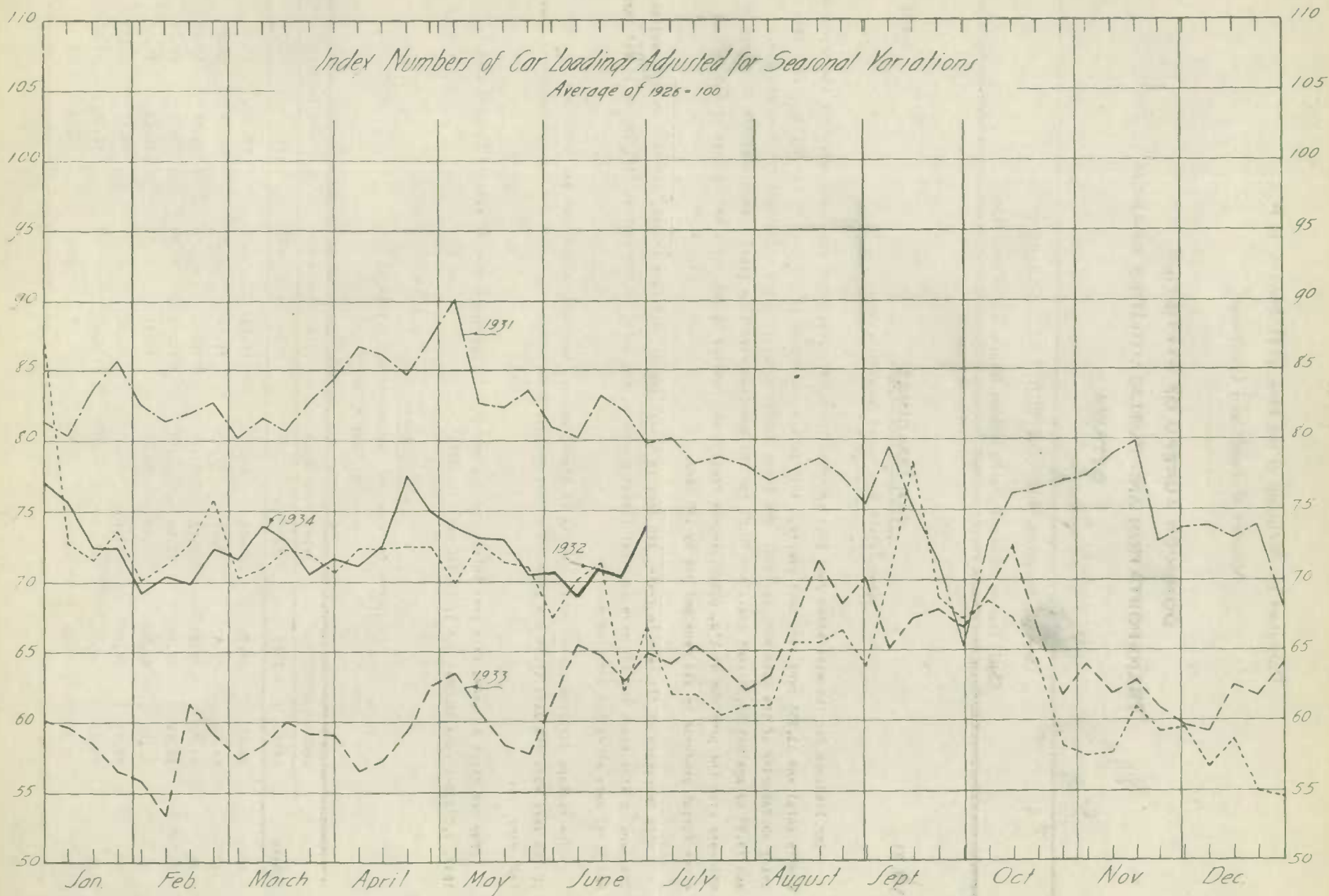

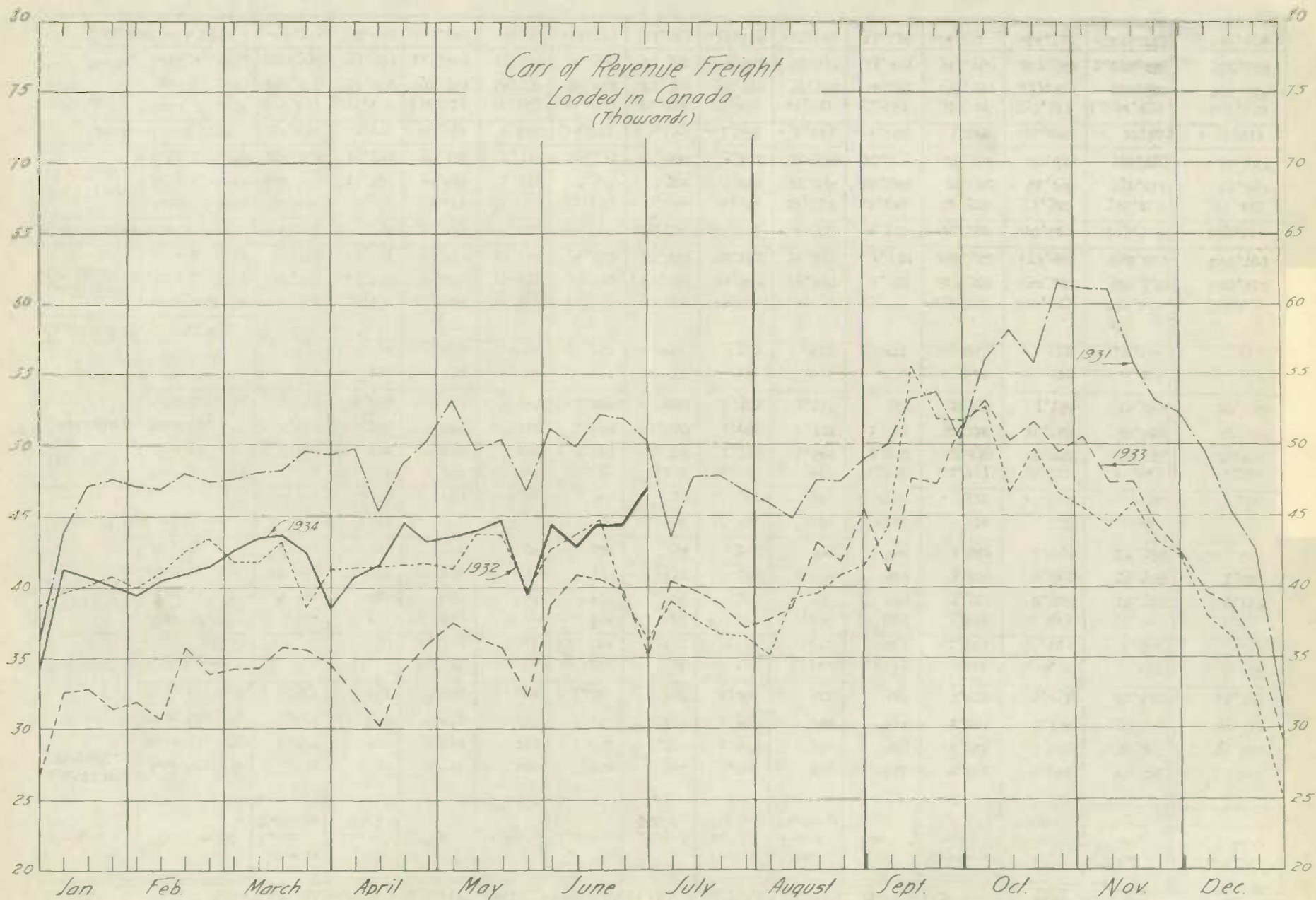
